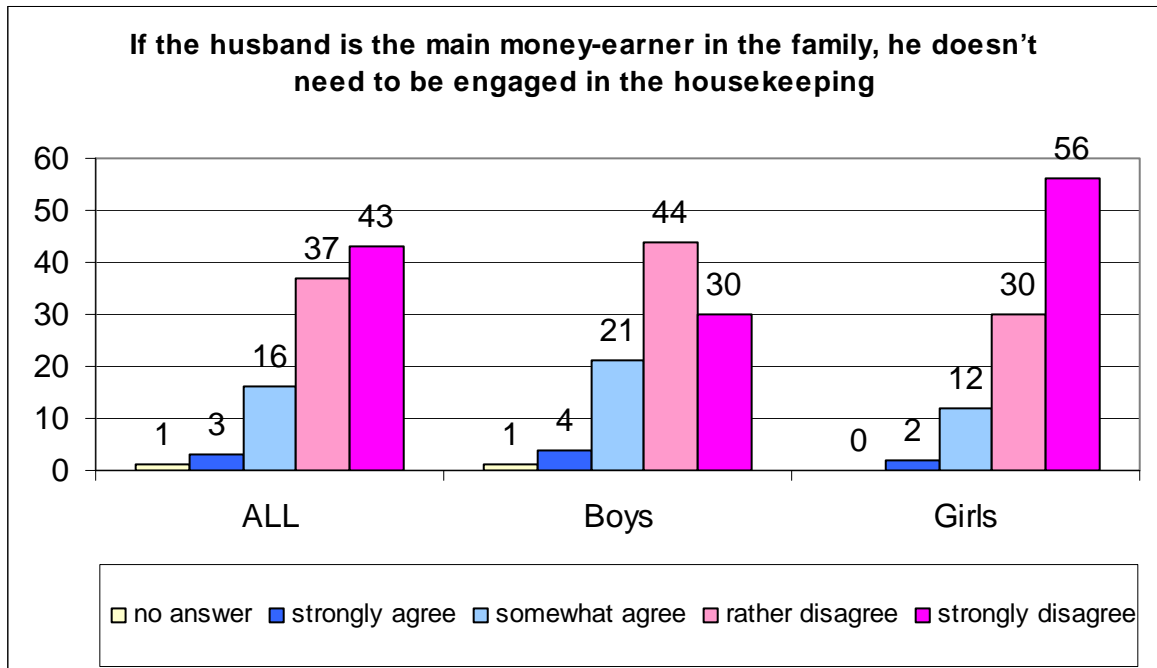
DIFFERENCES BY GENDER



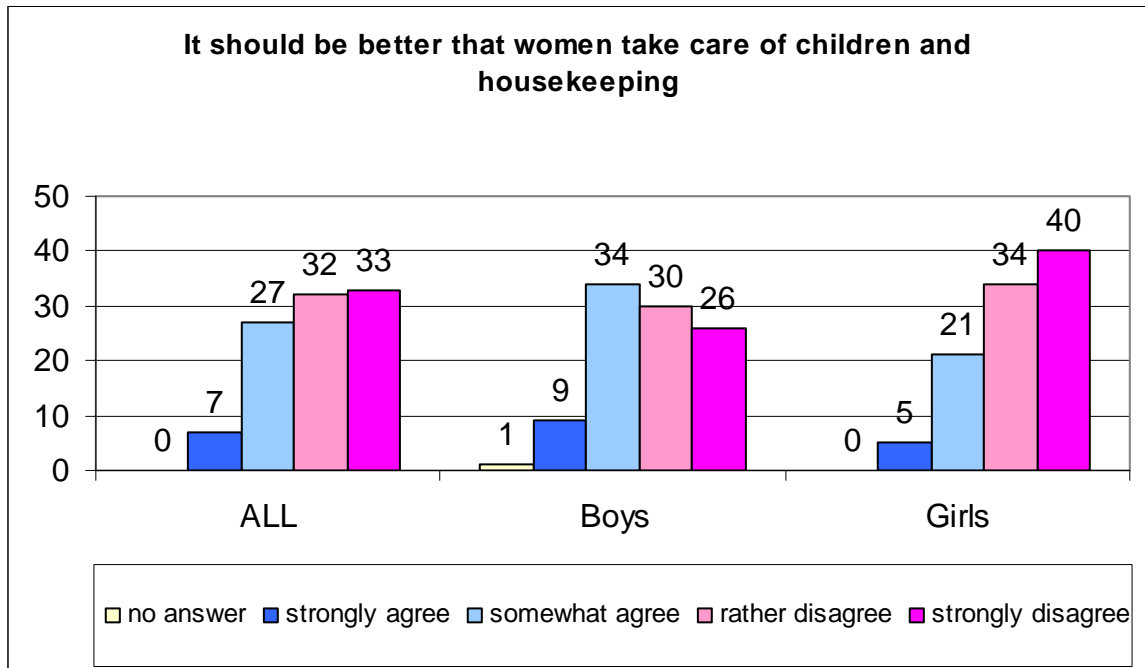
COMMENT: Over 2/3 (71%) of the students either strongly or rather disagree with this statement. Here we do though have strong gender difference since nearly 40% of the boys but only 18% of the girls strongly or somewhat agree with the statement.



COMMENT: Around 80% (78%) of the students did strongly or rather disagree the statement that a wife should not work if the husband earns enough money. There are gender differences in the answers since 85% of the girls strongly or rather disagree with the statement but 70% of the boys.

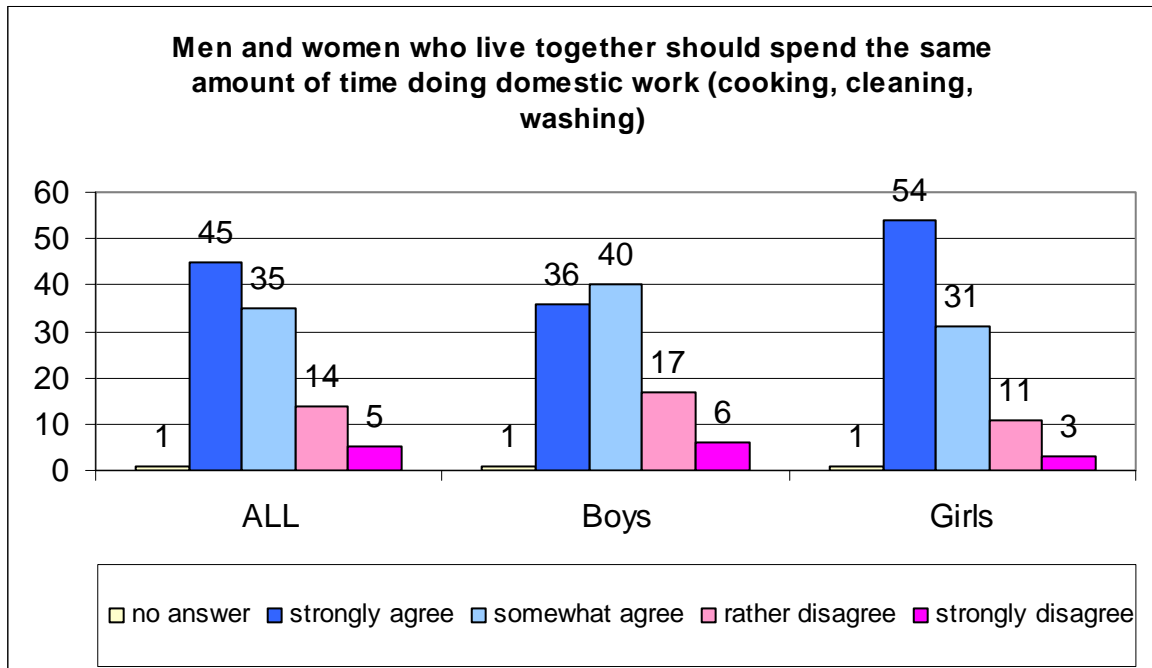


COMMENT: 80% of the students do strongly or rather disagree on this statement. There are huge gender differences between the answers, 56% of the girls strongly disagree on the statement but only 30% of the boys. One fourth of the boys (25%) did strongly or somewhat agree with the statement but only 14% of the girls.



COMMENT:

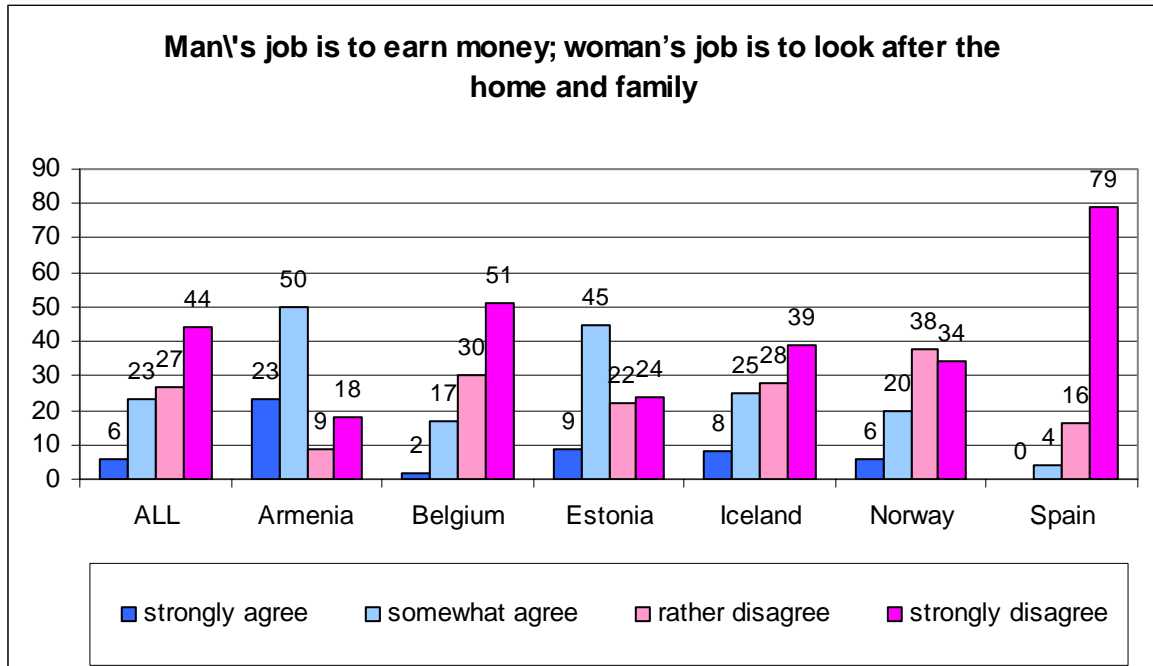
Nearly 2/3 of all students where rather or strongly disagree on this statement. There are significant gender differences in answering this questions, 56% of the boys did rather or strongly disagree that it should be better that women take care of children and housekeeping compared with 74% of the girls.



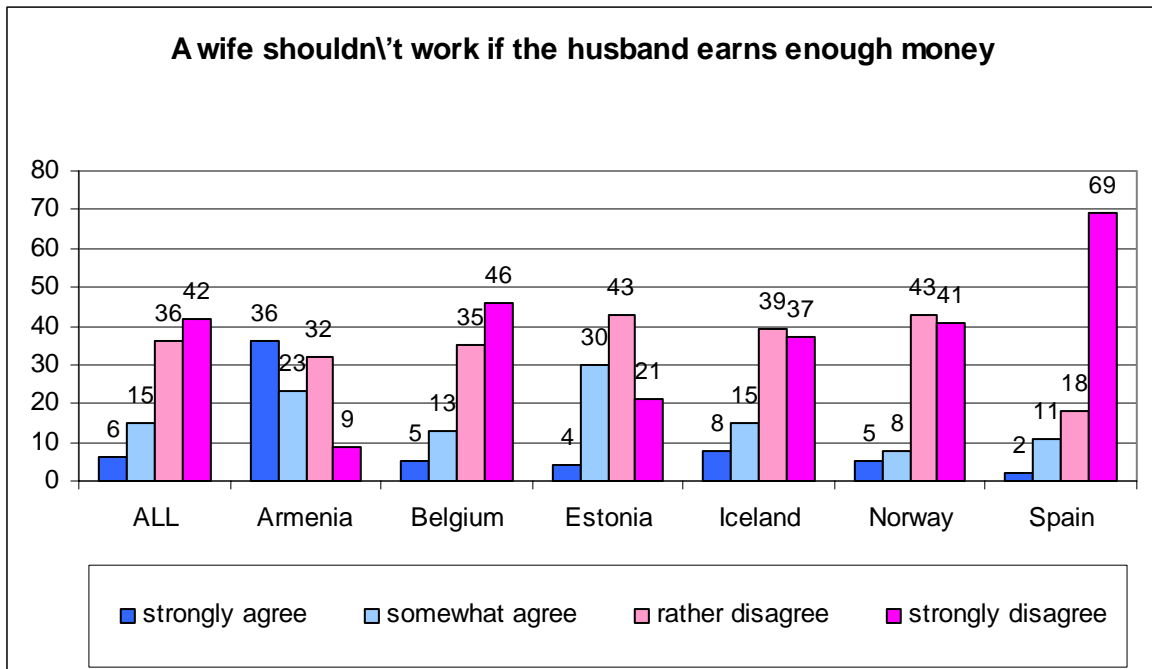
COMMENT:

80% of the students did strongly or somewhat agree on this statement. There are gender differences in the answers since more girls (85%) than boys (76%) strongly or somewhat agree on that men and women who live together should spend the same amount of time doing domestic work.

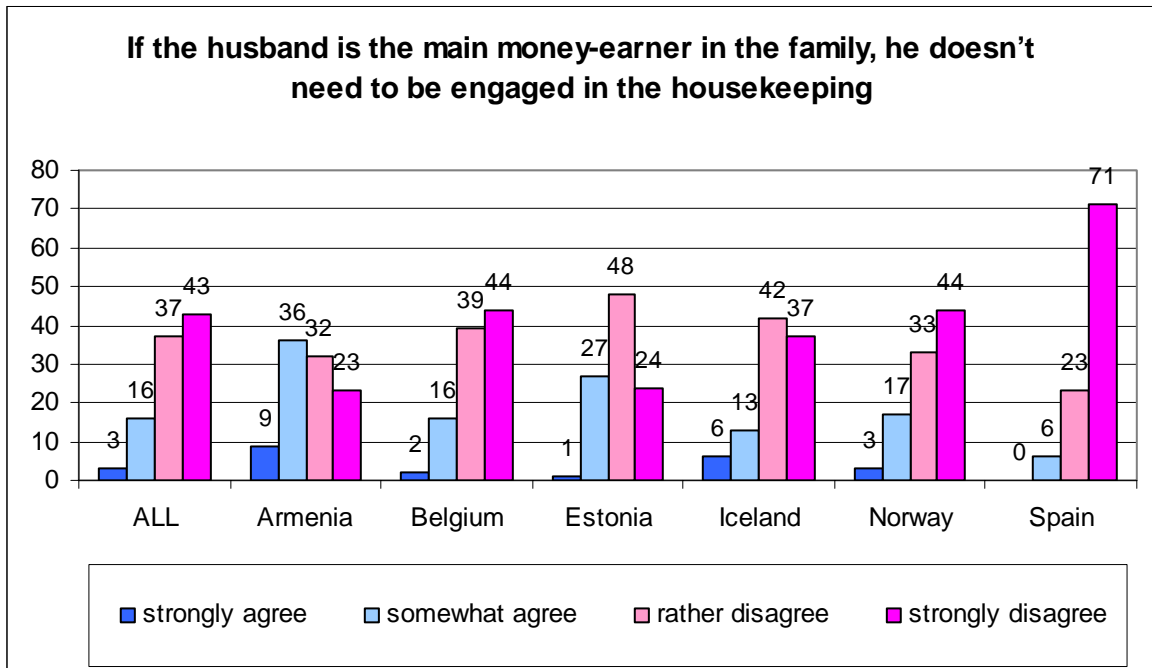

DIFFERENCES IN EVERY COUNTRY BETWEEN BOYS AND GIRLS

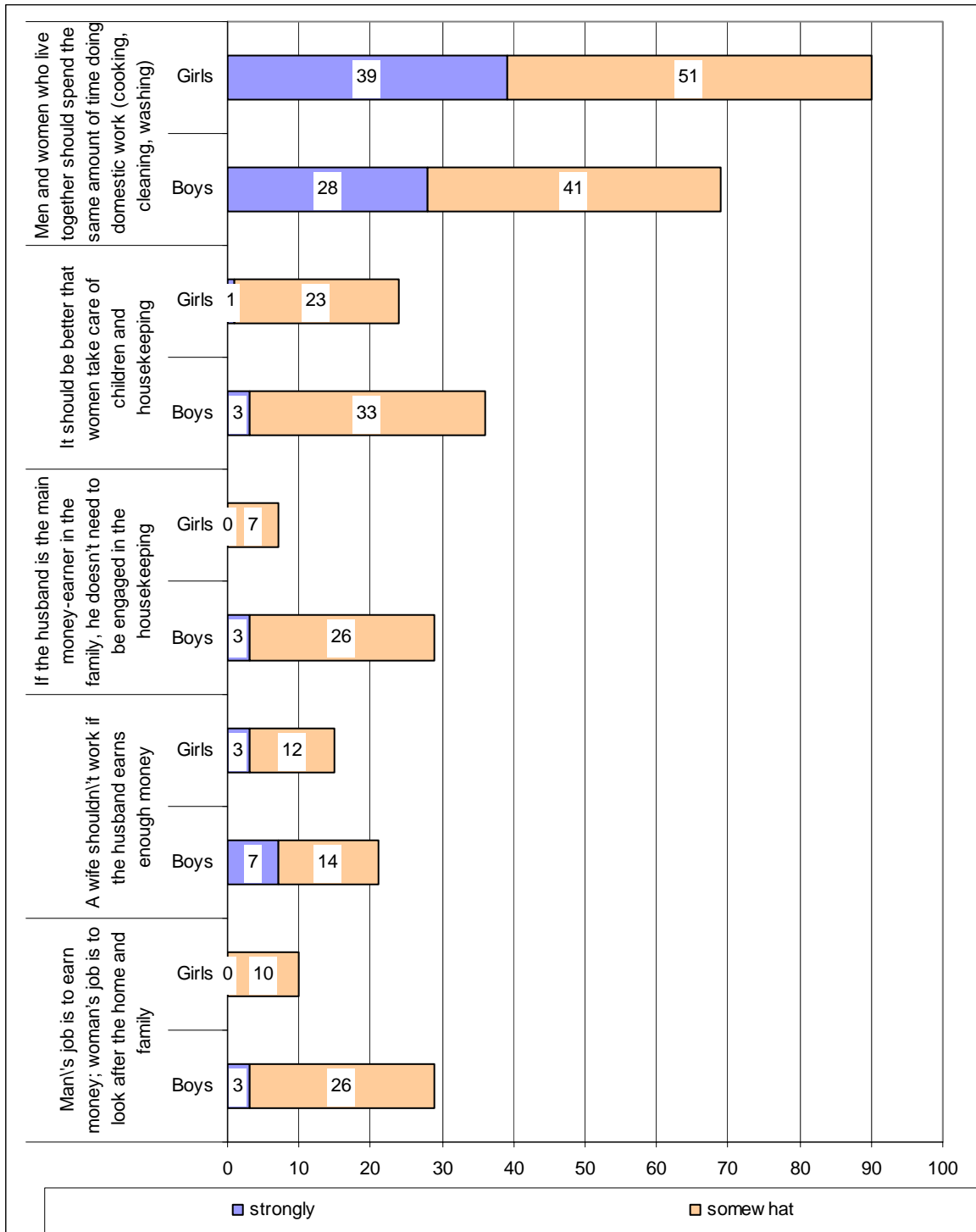
I – ARMENIA – agreeing with statements



Armenia

- Armenian boys are more liberal than Armenian girls on that men and women who lives together should spend the same amount of time doing domestic work, since 60% of them strongly or somewhat agree with the statement but only 34% of the girls.
- Almost all of the boys (90%) did strongly or somewhat agree on that it should be better that women took care of children and housekeeping but only 67% of the girls did strongly or somewhat agree on the statement.
- Half of the Armenian boys (50%) do agree (strongly or somewhat) that if the man is the main money-earner in the family, he doesn't need to be engaged in housekeeping but 41% of the girls did agree (strongly or somewhat).
- Majority of both sexes agree (strongly or somewhat) that a wife shouldn't work if the husband earns enough money, or 60% of the boys and 59% of the girls.
- Almost all of the Armenian boys (90%) did agree (strongly or somewhat) on that man's job is to earns money; woman's job is to look after the home and family compared with 58% of the Armenian girls.

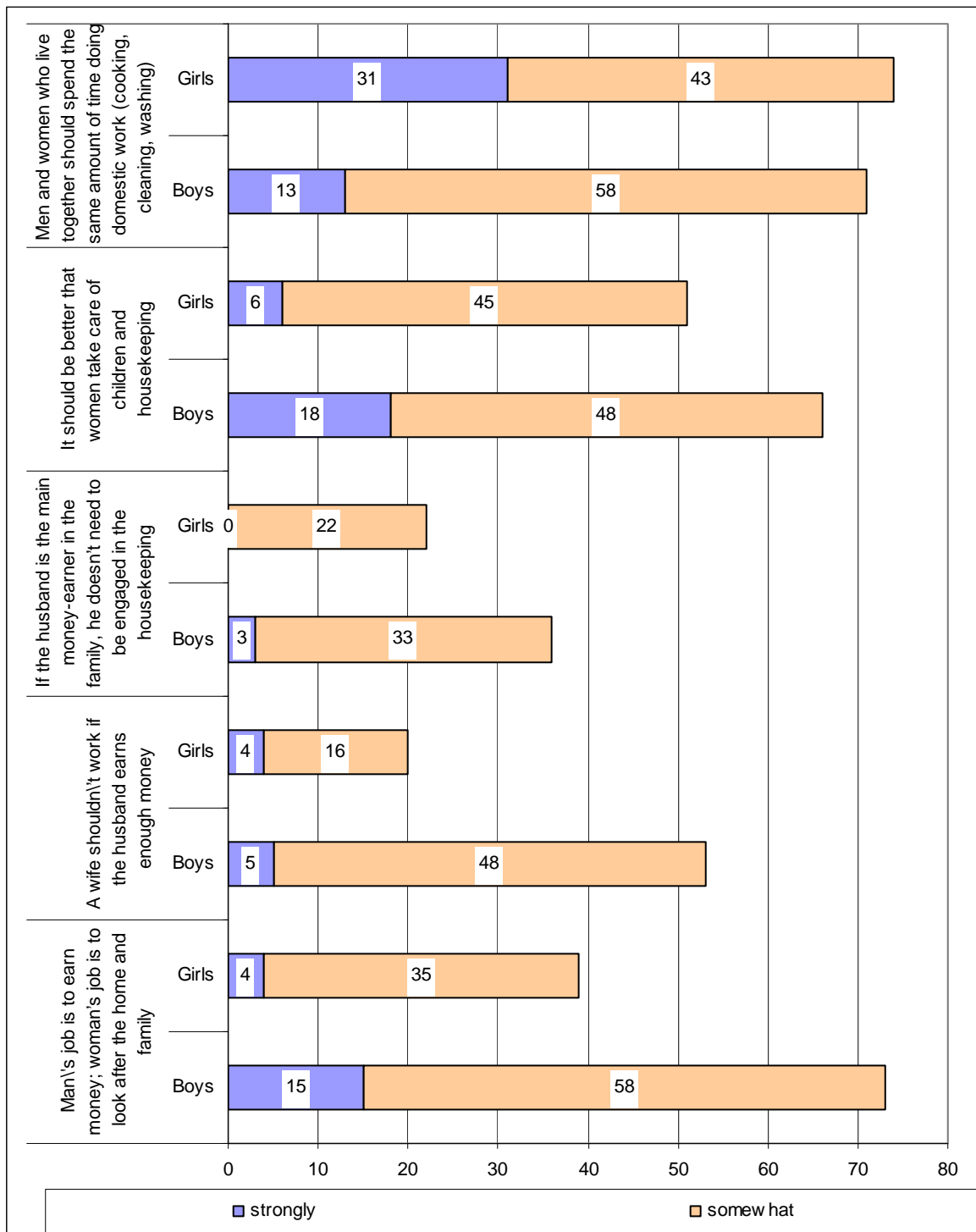
- II – BELGIUM – agreeing with statements



Belgium

- Almost all the Belgian girls (90%) agree (strongly or somewhat) on that men and women who lives together should spend the same amount of time doing domestic work and 69% of the Belgian boys share their opinion.
- A minority of the Belgian students think that it should be better that women took care of children and housekeeping. Only 24% of the girls agree (strongly or somewhat) on the statement and 36% of the boys.
- Very few Belgian girls, or just 7% agree (strongly or somewhat) on that if the man is the main money-earner in the family, he doesn't need to be engaged in housekeeping compared with 29% of the Belgian boys.
- Very few Belgian students believes in that a wife shouldn't work if the husband earns enough money. 15% of the girls agree (strongly or somewhat) on the statement but 21% of the boys.
- Minority of the Belgian students believes that man's job is to earns money; woman's job is to look after the home and family. No Belgian girl did strongly agree on the statement and but 10% of them did somewhat agree. Of the boys, only 3% did strongly agree on the statement but around one of four (26%) did somewhat agree with the statement.

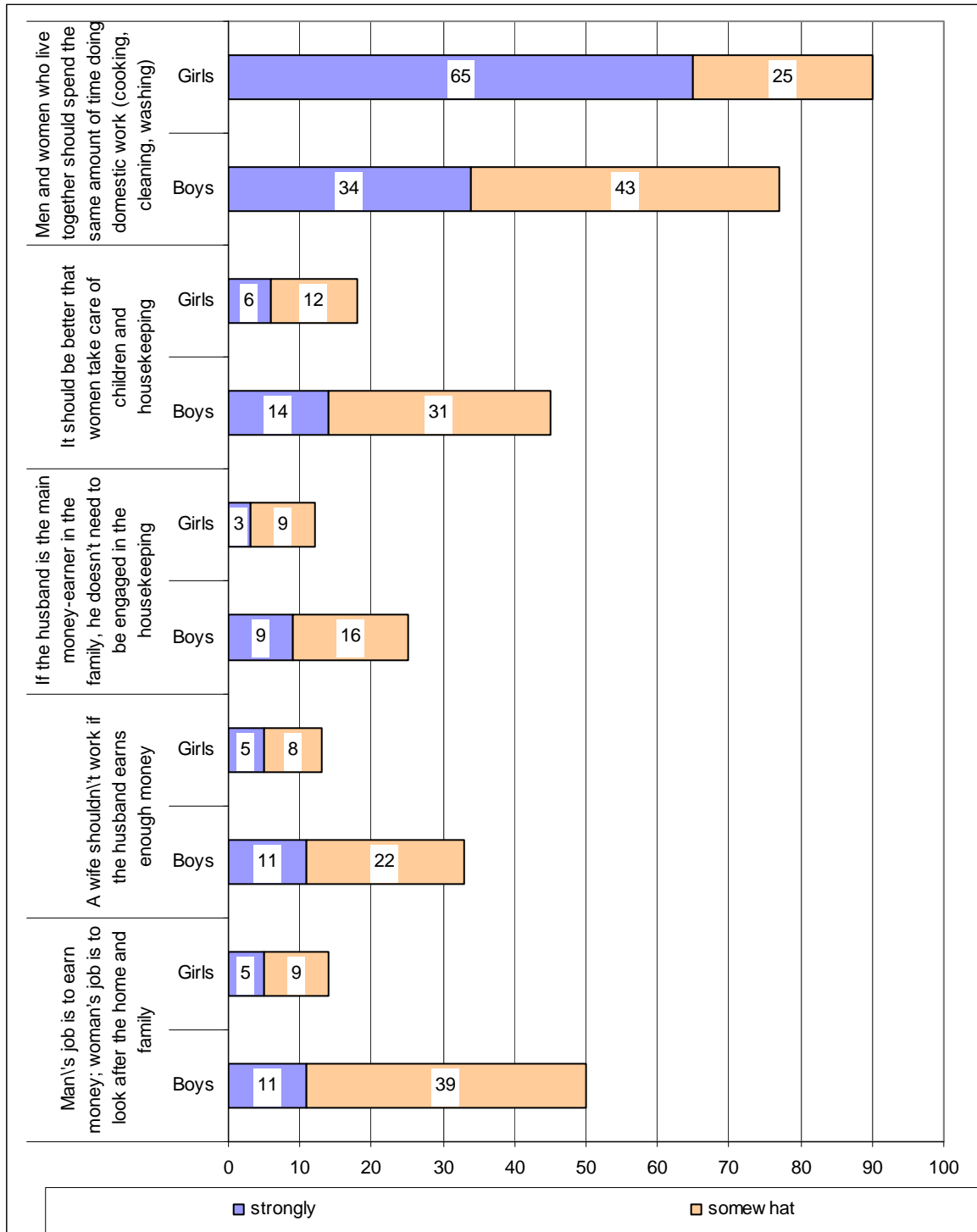
III – ESTONIA – agreeing with statements



Estonia

- More than 2/3 of the Estonians believe that men and women who lives together should spend the same amount of time doing domestic work. 74% of the girls agree (strongly 31% or somewhat 43%) on the statement and 71% of the boys (strongly 13% or somewhat 58%).
- A slight majority of the girls or 51% believes that it should be better that women took care of children and housekeeping but 66% of the boys agree on this statement. 6% of the girls and 18% of the boys strongly agree on the statement but 45% of the girls and 48% of the boys agree somewhat.
- The majority of the Estonian students does not agree on that if the man is the main money-earner in the family, he doesn't need to be engaged in housekeeping. None of the Estonian girls did agrees strongly on that statement and only 3% of the boys did so. 22% of the Estonian girls do somewhat agree on the statement and 33% of the boys.
- The majority of the Estonian boys agrees (strongly 5% or somewhat 48%) on that a wife shouldn't work if the husband earns enough money. Only 20% of the girls did agree (strongly 4% or somewhat 16%) on the statement.
- Almost 3 of 4 (73%) of the Estonian boys agrees (strongly 15% or somewhat 58%) that man's job is to earns money; woman's job is to look after the home and family. 39% of the girls agreed on the statement, 4% strongly and 35 somewhat 58%.

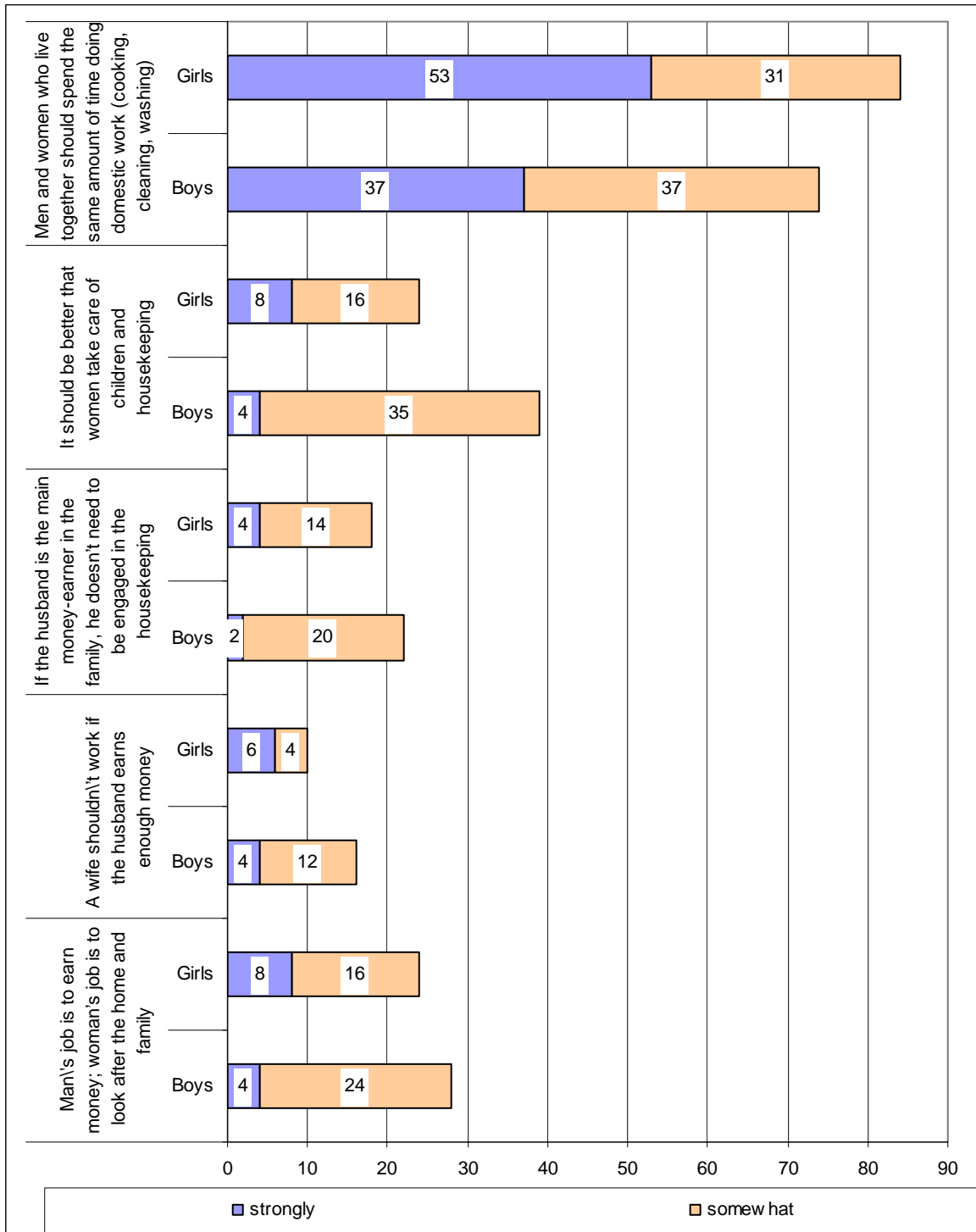
IV – ICELAND – agreeing with statements



Iceland

- Almost all or 90% of the Icelandic girls and 77 % of the boys agree (strongly or somewhat) that men and women who lives together should spend the same amount of time doing domestic work. 65% of the girls do strongly agree with the statement but only 34% of the boys.
- Nearly half of the boys or 45% agree strongly (14%) or somewhat (31%) that it should be better that women took care of children and housekeeping, but only 18% agree on the statement (strongly 6% or somewhat 12%).
- The majority of Icelandic students do not agree on the statement that if the man is the main money-earner in the family, he doesn't need to be engaged in housekeeping. One of four boys (25%) agree on that 9% of them strongly agree and 16% somewhat. Only 12% of the girls agree, 3% of them says they strongly agree and 9% somewhat.
- 33% of Icelandic boys agree on the statement that a wife shouldn't work if the husband earns enough money but only 13% of the girls. 11% of the boys did strongly agree and 22% somewhat but the figures for the girls where that 5% of them did strongly agree and 8% somewhat.
- Half of the Icelandic boys (50%) agree on the statement that man's job is to earns money; woman's job is to look after the home and family, 11% of them did strongly agree and 39% somewhat. Only 14% of the girls did agree on the statement, 5% of them strongly and 9% somewhat.

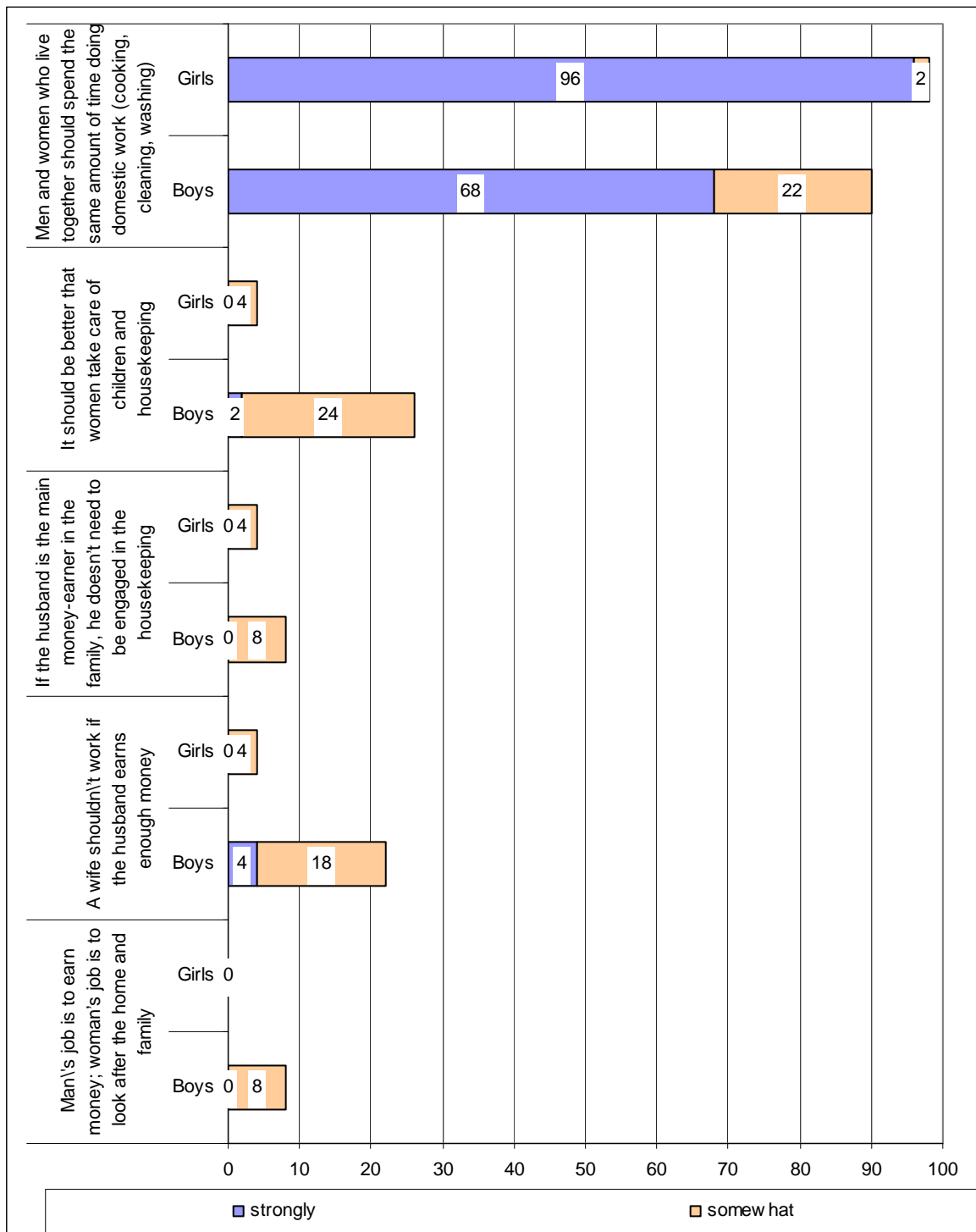
- V – NORWAY – agreeing with statements



Norway

- The majority of Norwegian students do agree on the statement that men and women who lives together should spend the same amount of time doing domestic work. 84% of the girls did agree, 53% strongly and 31% somewhat. 74% of the boys agree on the statement, 37% strongly and 37% somewhat.
- Almost one of four girls (24%) did agree on the statement that it should be better that women took care of children and housekeeping, thereof 8% strongly and 16% somewhat. 39% of the boys did agree, thereof only 4% strongly and 35% somewhat.
- Only 18% of the girls and 22% of the boys did agree on the statement that if the man is the main money-earner in the family, he doesn't need to be engaged in housekeeping. 4% of the girls did strongly agree and 14% somewhat. Only 2% of the boys strongly agreed and 20% of them agreed somewhat.
- Only 10% of the girls and 16% of the boys agreed on that a wife shouldn't work if the husband earns enough money. 6% of the girls and 4% of the boys did strongly agree and 4% of the girls and 12% of the boys did somewhat agree.
- Only 24% of the girls and 28% of the boys did agree on that man's job is to earns money; woman's job is to look after the home and family. 8% of the girls did strongly agree but only 4% of the boys. 16% of the girls did somewhat agree on the statement and 24% of the boys.

VI – SPAIN – agreeing with statements

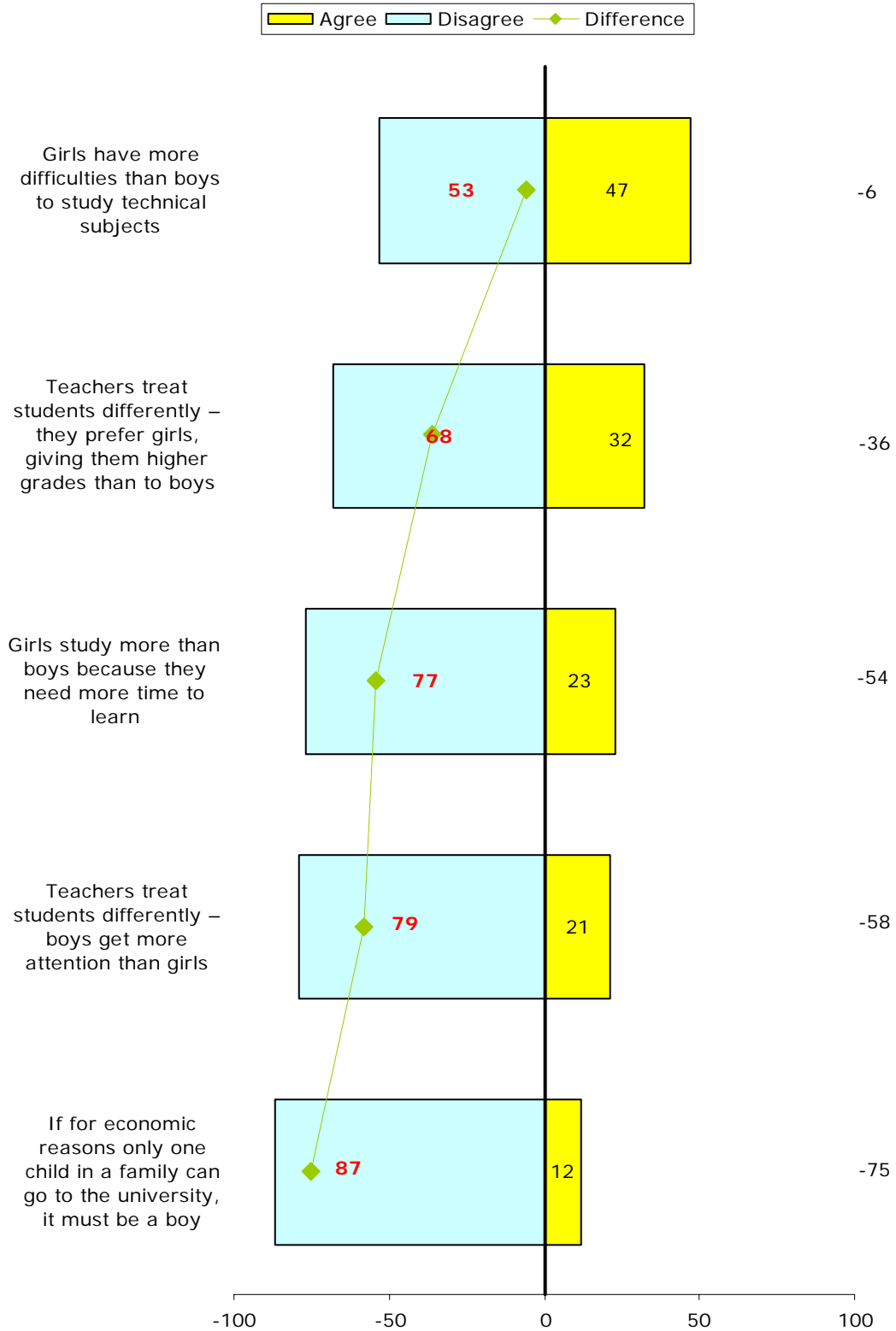


Spain

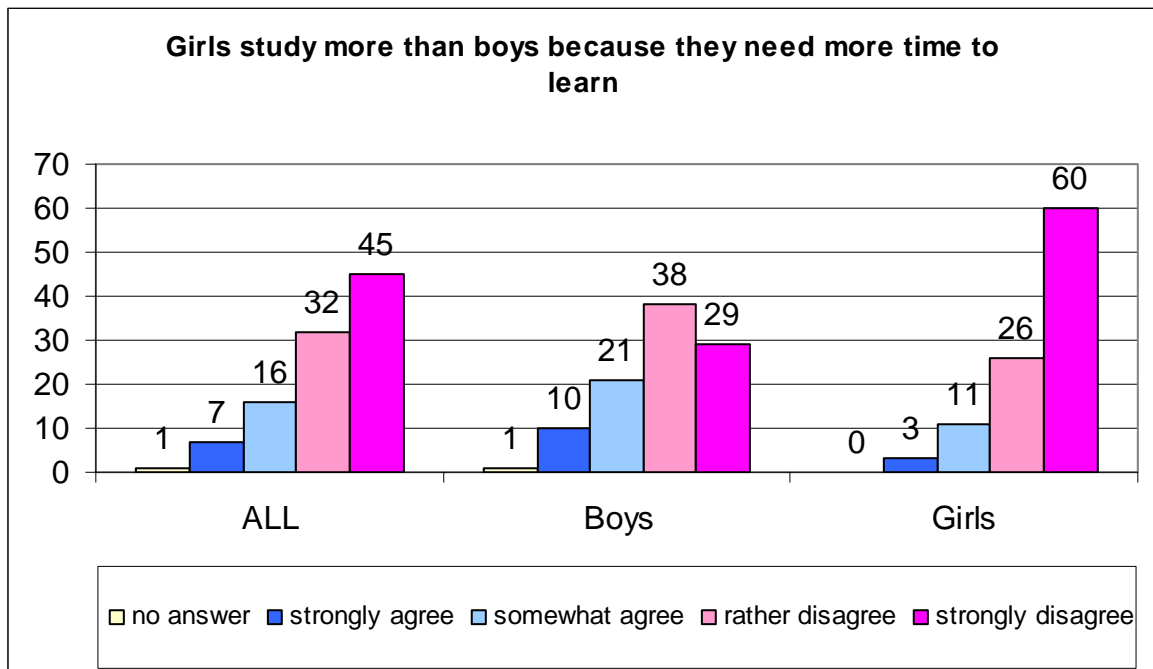
- The majority of Spanish students do agree on the statement that men and women who lives together should spend the same amount of time doing domestic work. 98% of the girls did agree, 96% of them strongly. 90% of the boys did agree on the statement, 68% strongly and 22% somewhat.
- Only 4% of Spanish girls did agree (somewhat, none strongly) that it should be better that women took care of children and housekeeping! One of four boys or 26% did agree, 2% strongly and 24% somewhat.
- Only 4% of Spanish girls did agree (somewhat, none strongly) that if the man is the main money-earner in the family, he doesn't need to be engaged in housekeeping. Only 8% of Spanish boy did agree (somewhat, none strongly) on the statement.
- Only 4% of Spanish girls did agree (somewhat, none strongly) that a wife shouldn't work if the husband earns enough money. 22% of the boys did agree on this statement, 4% strongly and 18% somewhat.
- None of the Spanish girl (0%) agreed on that man's job is to earns money; woman's job is to look after the home and family. Only 8% of the boys did agree somewhat on the statement, none (0%) strongly.

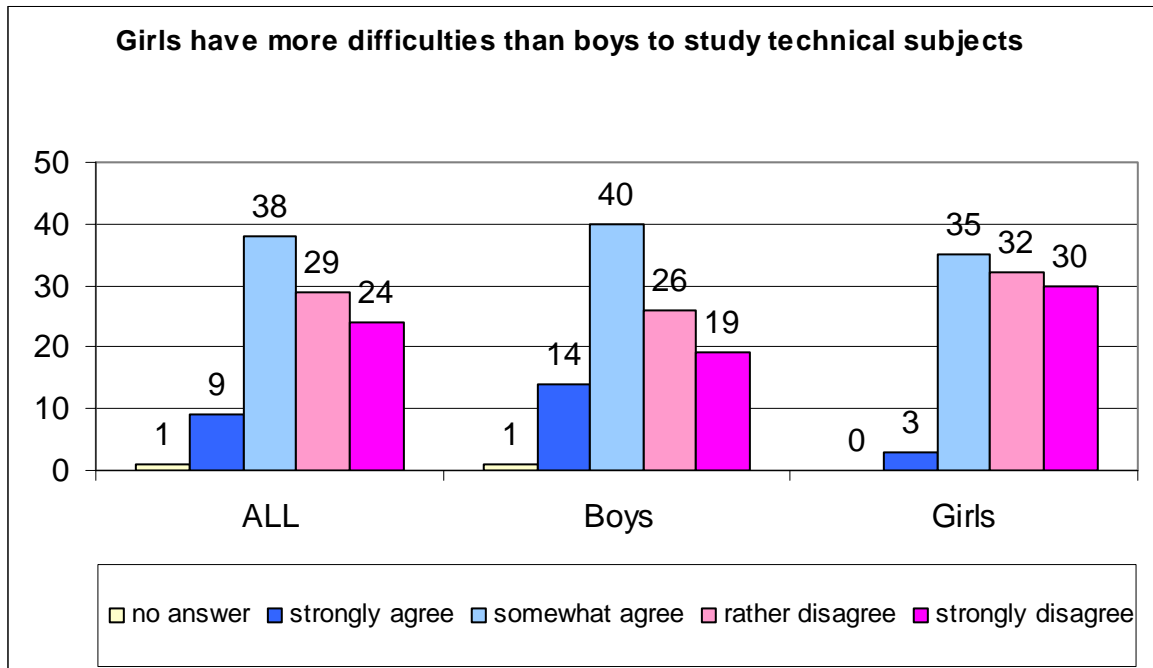

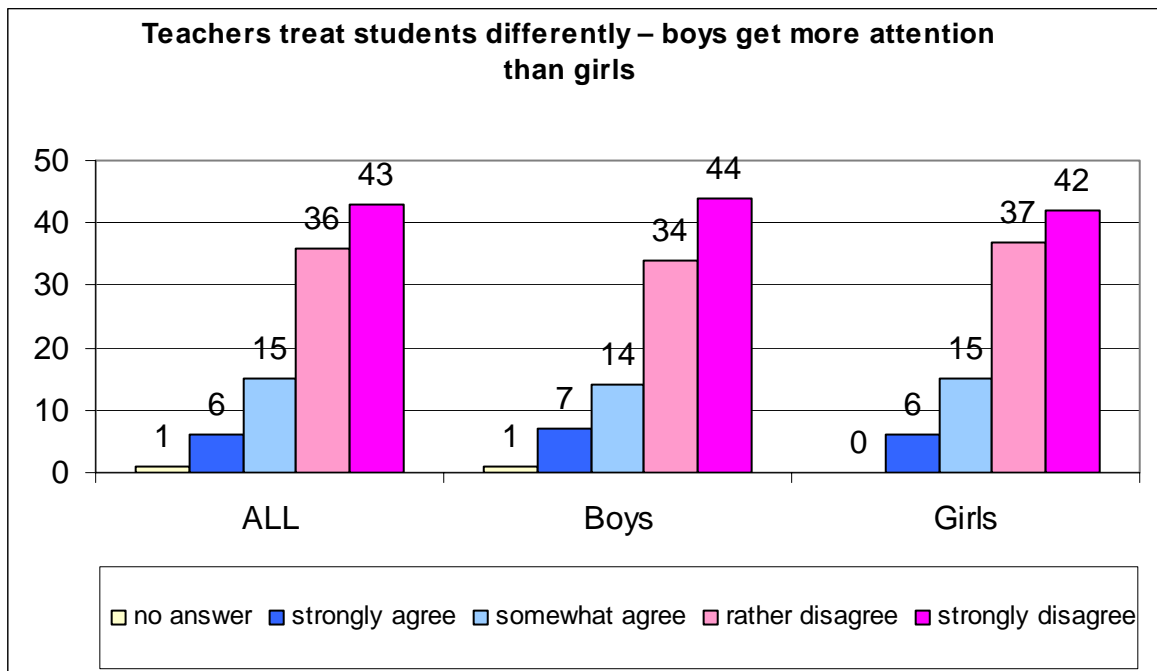

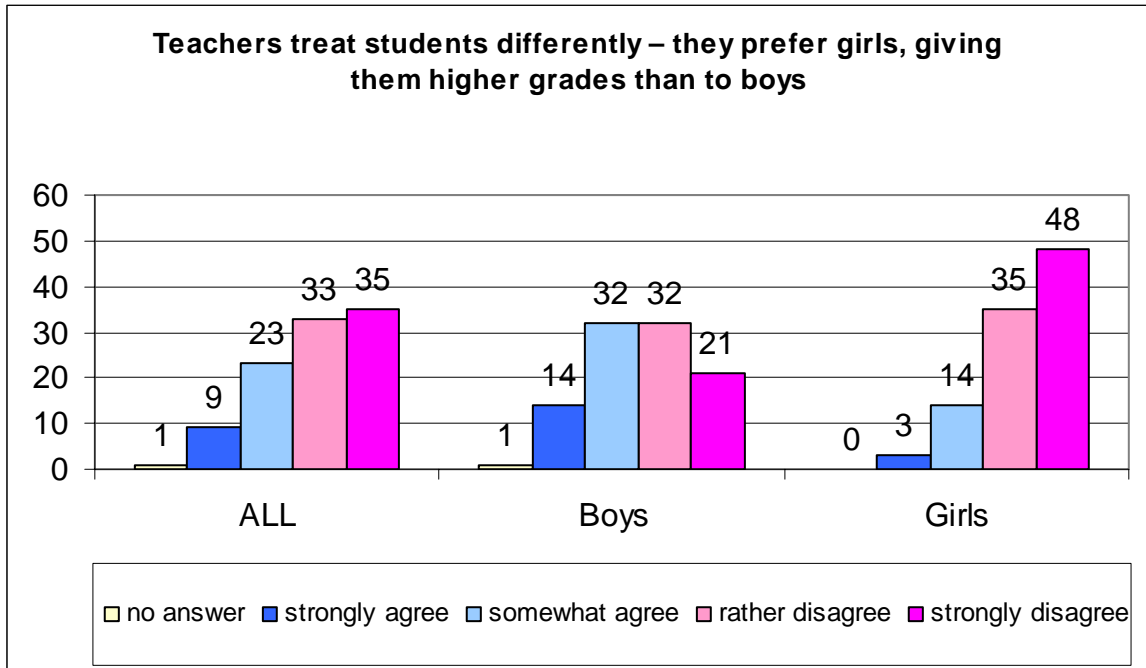
COMMENTS: Only 23% agreed on that girls study more than boys because they need more time to learn. More boys (31%) than girls (14%) did agree on the statement. 10% of the boys and 3% of the girls did strongly agree, and 21% of the boys and 11% of the girls did somewhat agree.



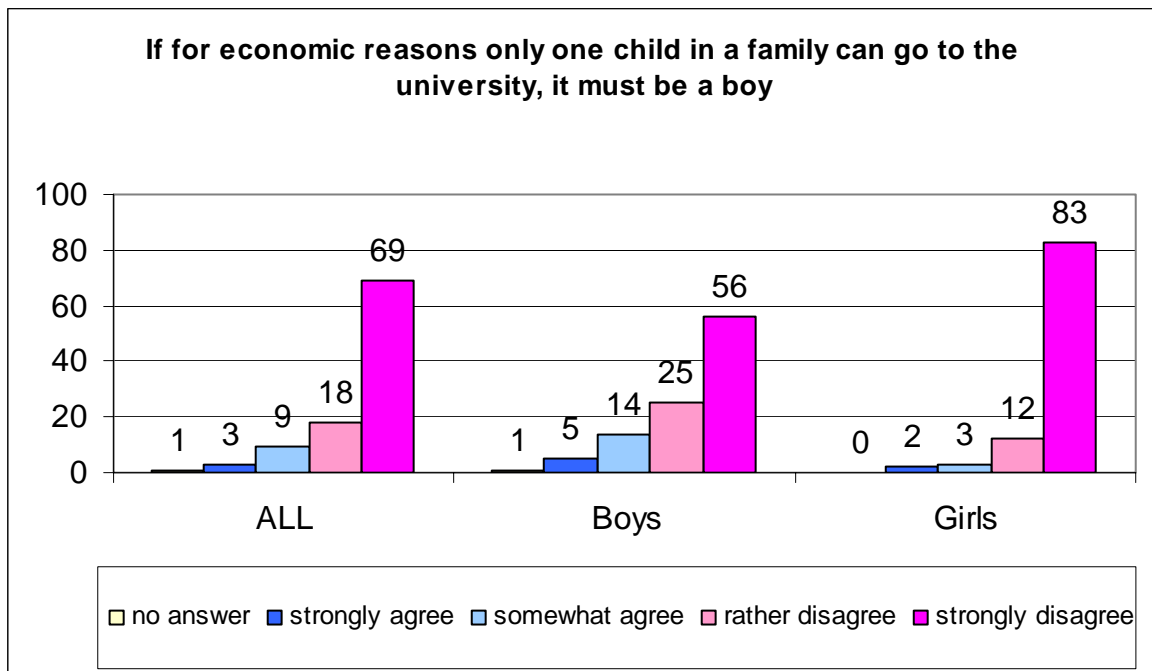
COMMENT: 47% did agree on that girls have more difficulties than boys to study technical subjects. More boys (54%) than girls (38%) did agree the statement, 14% of the boys and 3% of the girls strongly agreed and 40% of the boys and 35% of the girls somewhat agreed.



COMMENT: Only 21% did agree on that teachers treat students differently – boys get more attention than girls. The answers between the sexes are almost identical, 7% of the boys and 6% of the girls did strongly agree and 14% of the boys and 15% of the girls did somewhat agree.



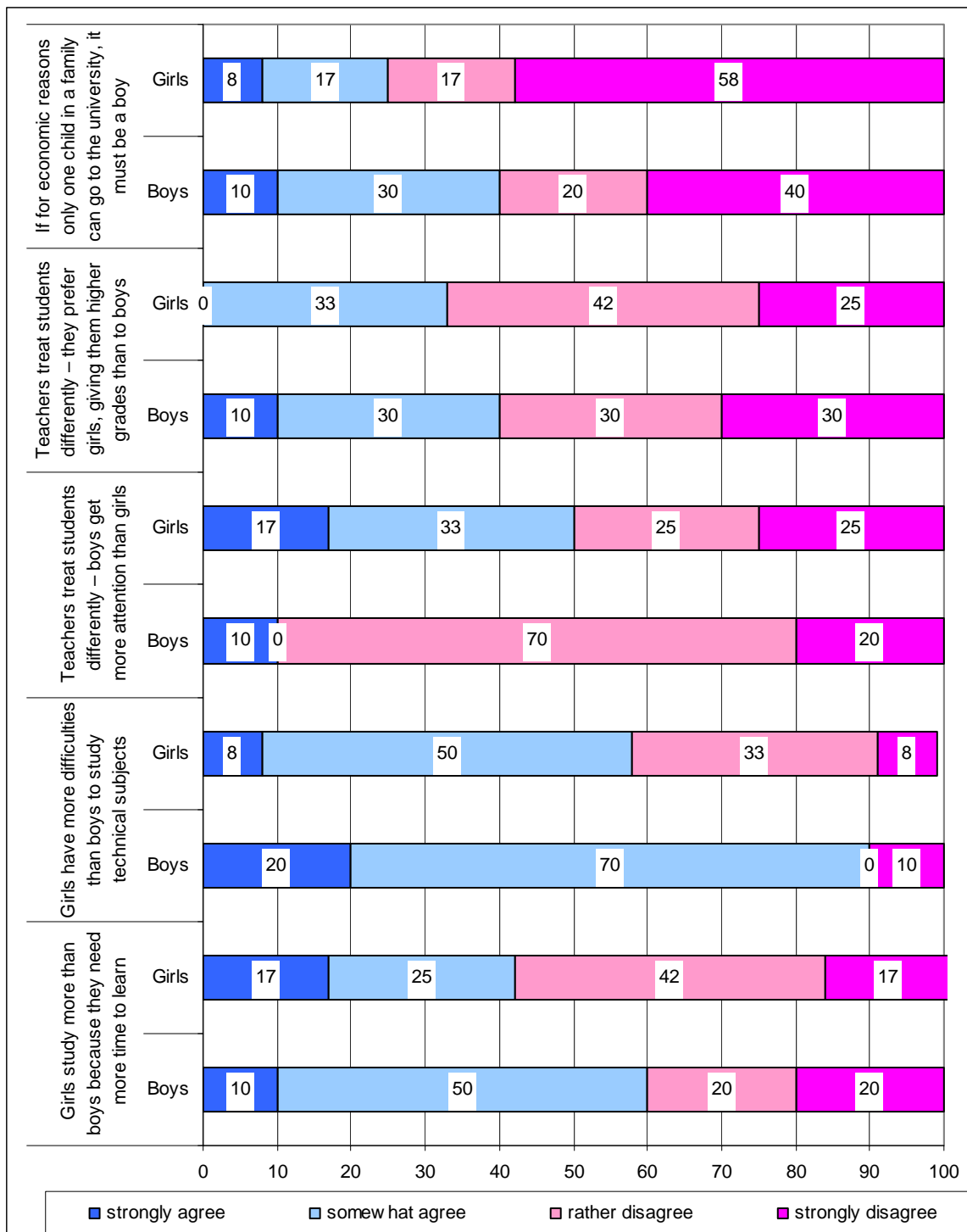
COMMENT: 32% believes that teachers treat students differently – they prefer girls, giving them higher grades than to boys. There is significant difference in answers between sexes, nearly half of the boys (46%) did agree on the statement (14% strongly and 32% somewhat) but only 17% of the girls (3% strongly and 14% somewhat).



COMMENT: 2/3 (69%) did strongly disagree that if for economic reasons only one child in a family can go to the university, it must be a boy. 95% of the girls did disagree this statement (83% strongly) and 81% of the boys (56% strongly).

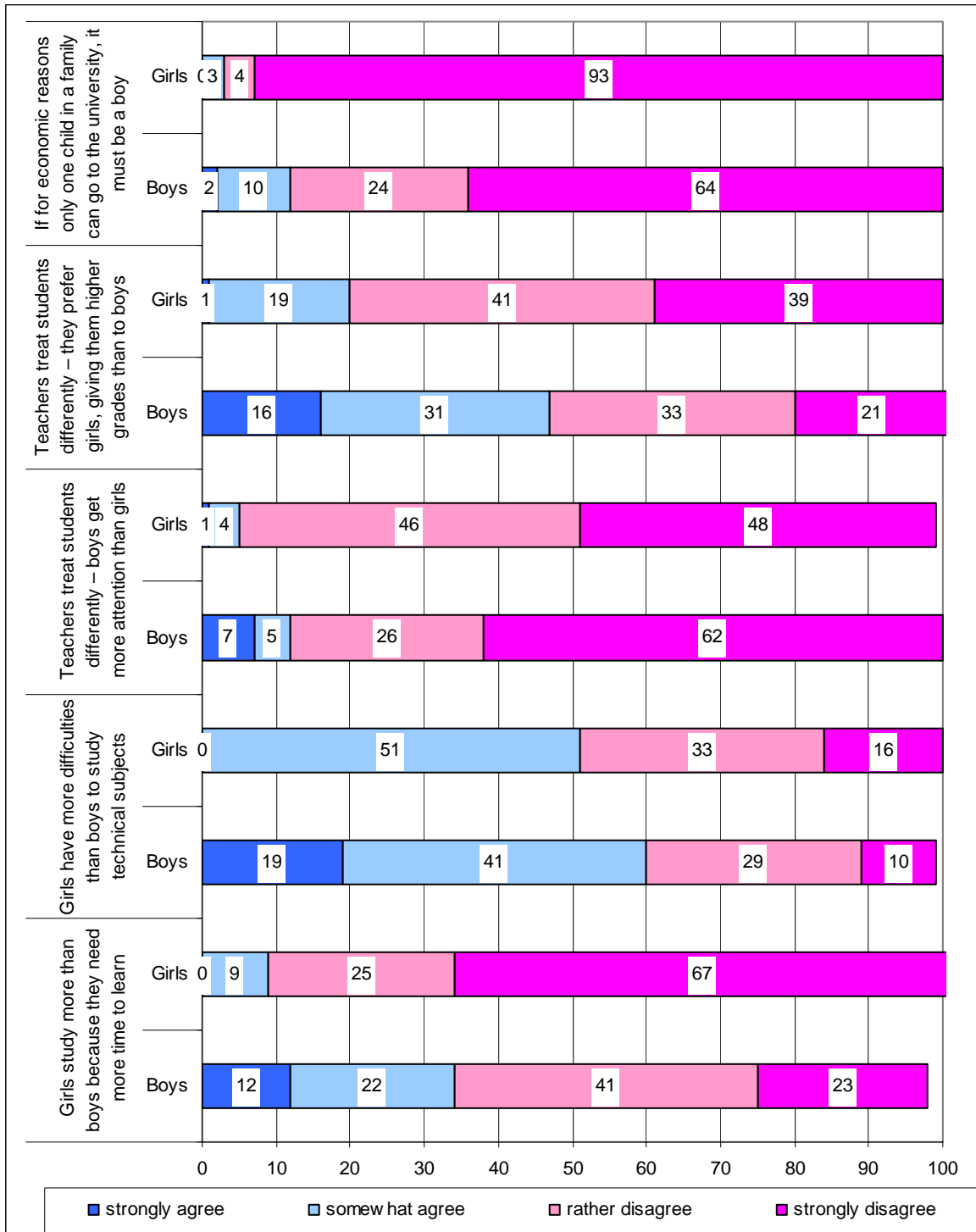
ARMENIA



Armenia:

- $\frac{3}{4}$ of the Armenian girls (75%) did either strongly disagree (58%) or rather disagree (17%) on the statement that if for economic reasons only one child in a family can go to the university, it must be a boy. Fewer boys than girls or 60% did either strongly disagree (40%) or rather disagree (20%) on this statement.
- Nearly $\frac{2}{3}$ of the girls (67%) and 60% of the boys did rather or strongly disagree on the statement that teachers treat students differently – they prefer girls, given them higher grades than to boys. None of the girls and 10% of the boys did strongly agree on the statement.
- Half of the girls (50%) and 90% of the boys did rather or strongly disagree on the statement that teachers treat students differently – boys get more attention than girls. Only 10% of the boys and 17% of the girls did strongly agree on this statement.
- Nearly all or 90% of the boys and 58% of the girls did agree strongly or somewhat that girls have more difficulties than boys to study technical subjects. 20% of the boys and 8% of the girls did strongly agree with this statement.
- 60% of the boys did strongly or somewhat agree on that girls study more than boys because they need more time to learn while Almost 60% of the girls (59%) did rather or strongly disagree on that statement. Most of the boys or 50% did somewhat agree with the statement and most of the girls or 42% did rather disagree on the statement.

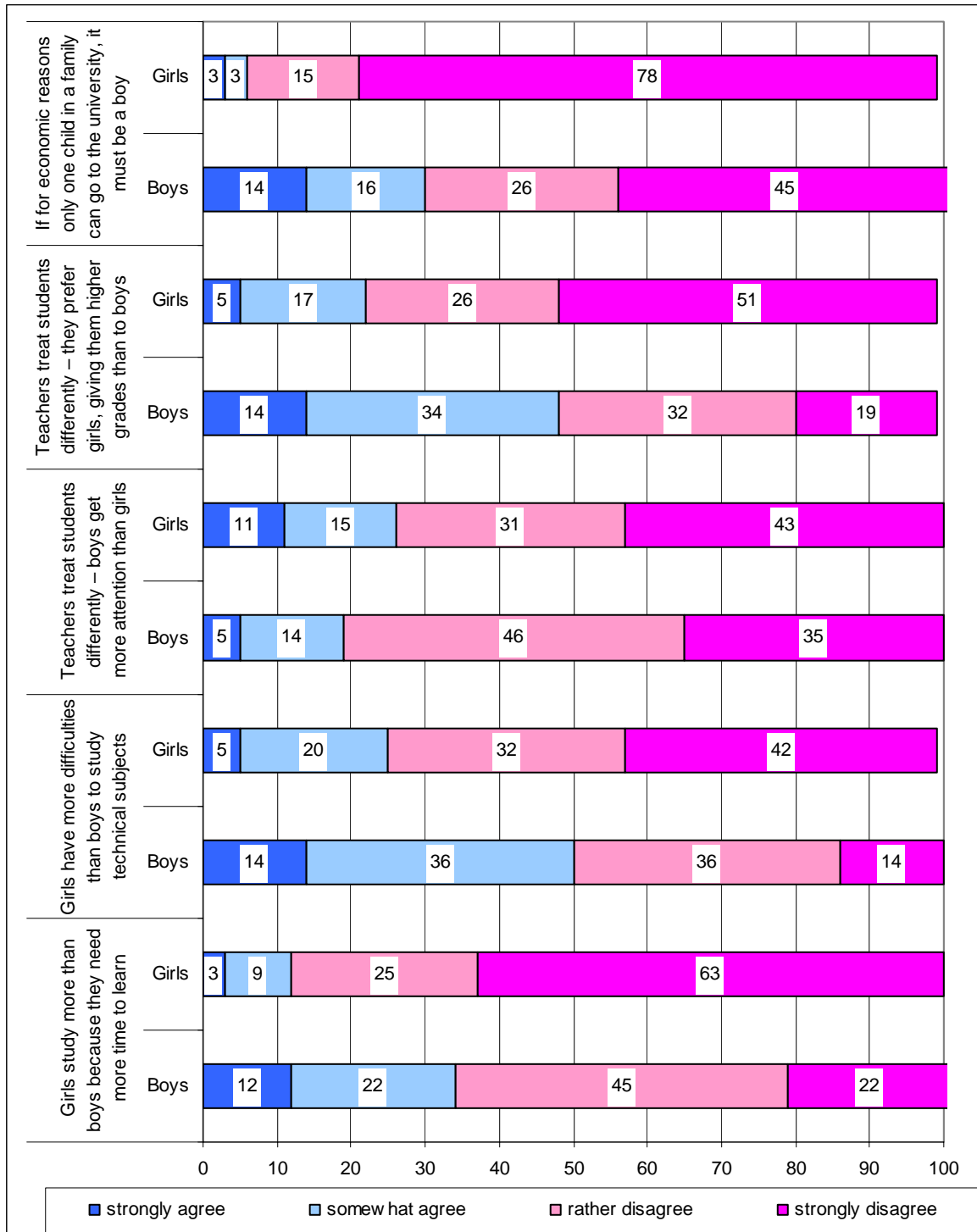
- BELGIUM



Belgium

- 93% of the girls and 64% of the Belgian students did strongly disagree on the statement that if for economic reasons only one child in a family can go to the university, it must be a boy. Only 5% of the students did strongly agree with the statement, 3% of the girls and 2% of the boys.
- 80% of the girls and 54% of the boys did rather or strongly disagree on the statement that teachers treat students differently – they prefer girls, given them higher grades than to boys. Only 1% of the girls and 16% of the boys did strongly agree on the statement.
- 94% of the girls and 88% of the boys did rather or strongly disagree on the statement that teachers treat students differently – boys get more attention than girls. Only 1% of the girls and 7% of the boys did strongly agree with the statement.
- 60% of the boys and 51% of the girls did agree on that girls have more difficulties than boys to study technical subjects. 19% of the boys did strongly believe in the statement, but none of the girls.
- Nearly 2/3 (67%) of the girls did strongly disagree on the statement that girls study more than boys because they need more time to learn while, but only 23% of the boys. 12% of the boys did strongly agree with the statement but none of the girls.

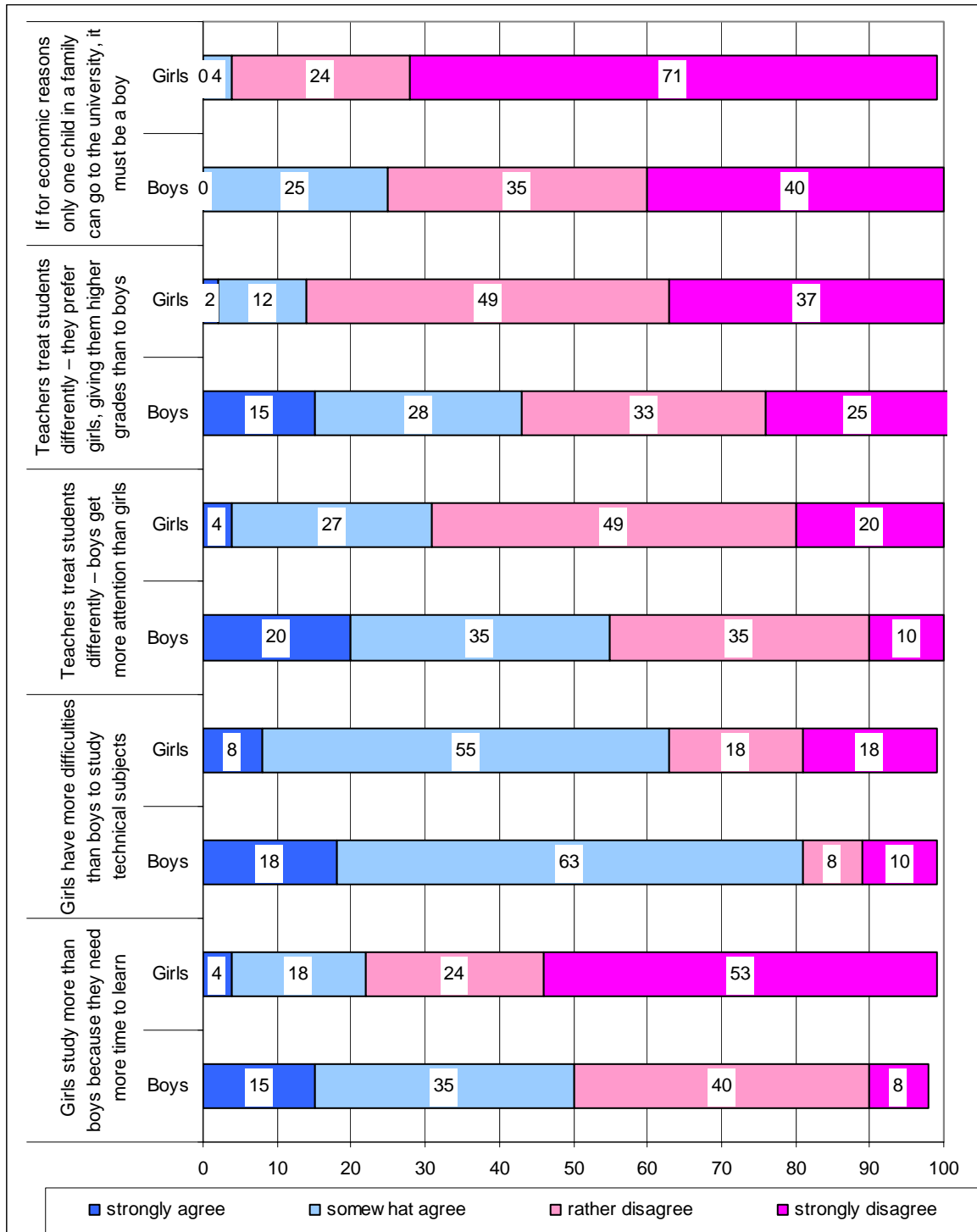
- ICELAND



Iceland

- 93% of the Icelandic girls and 71% of the boys did rather or strongly disagree on the statement that if for economic reasons only one child in a family can go to the university, it must be a boy. 17% of the students did strongly agree on the statement, 3% girls and 14% boys.
- 77% of the girls and 51% of the boys did rather or strongly disagree on the statement that teachers treat students differently – they prefer girls, given them higher grades than to boys. Only 19% of the students did strongly agree on the statement, 5% of the girls and 14% of the boys.
- 81% of the boys and 74% of the girls did rather or strongly disagree on the statement that teachers treat students differently – boys get more attention than girls. Only 16% of the students did strongly agree on the statement, 11% of the girls and 5% of the boys.
- 74% of the girls and 50% of the boys did rather or strongly disagree on the statement that girls have more difficulties than boys to study technical subjects. Only 19% of the students did strongly agree on the statement, 5% of the girls and 14% of the boys.
- 88% of the girls and 67% of the boys did rather or strongly disagree on the statement that girls study more than boys because they need more time to learn. Only 15% of the students did strongly agree with the statement, 3% of the girls and 12% of the boys.

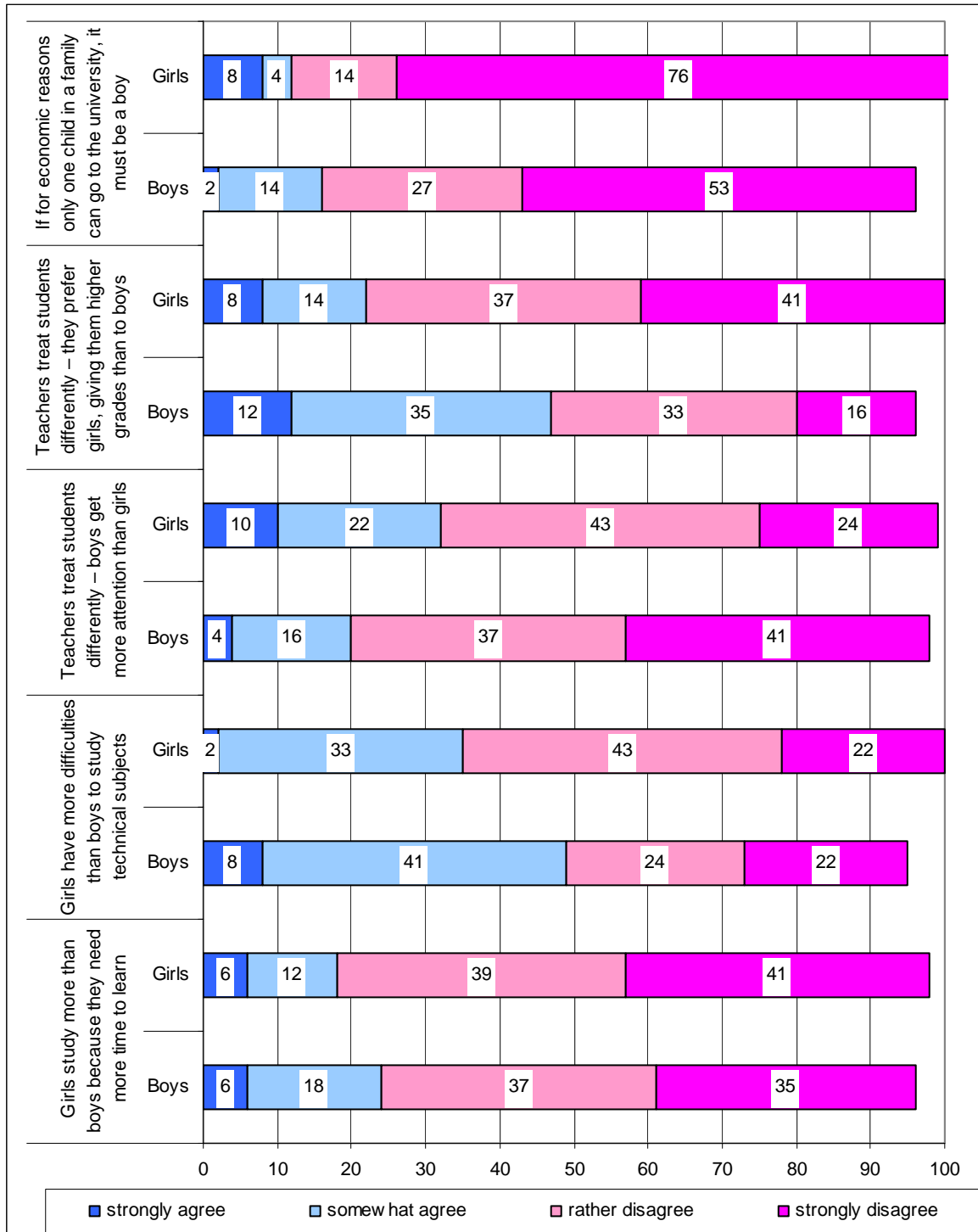
- ESTONIA



Estonia

- 95% of the Estonian girls and 75% of the boys did rather or strongly disagree on the statement that if for economic reasons only one child in a family can go to the university, it must be a boy. None of the students (0%) did strongly believe in the statement.
- 86% of the girls and 58% of the boys did rather or strongly disagree on the statement that teachers treat students differently – they prefer girls, given them higher grades than to boys. Only 17% of the students did strongly believe in the statement, 15% of the boys and 2% of the girls.
- 69% of the girls but only 45% of the boys did rather or strongly disagree on the statement that teachers treat students differently – boys get more attention than girls. Almost $\frac{1}{4}$ or (24%) of the students strongly believed in the statement, 20% of the boys and 4% of the girls.
- 81% of the boys and 63% of the girls did strongly or somewhat agree on that girls have more difficulties than boys to study technical subjects. 28% of the students did strongly disagree on the statement, 18% of the girls and 10% of the boys.
- 77% of the girls and 48% of the boys did rather or strongly disagree on the statement that girls study more than boys because they need more time to learn. 19% of the students did strongly agree on the statement, 15% of the boys and 4% of the girls.

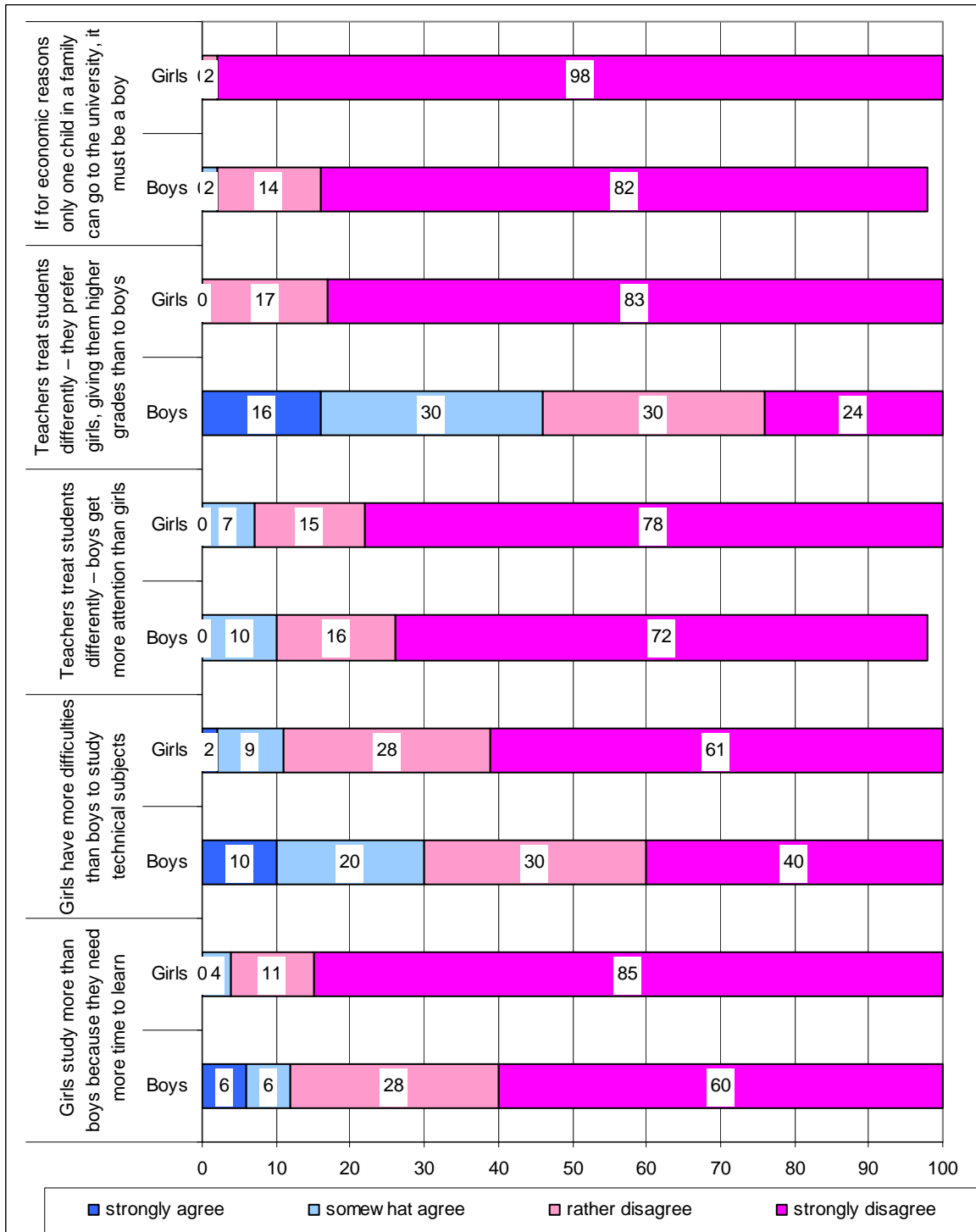
NORWAY



Norway

- 90% of the Norwegian girls and 80% of the boys did rather or strongly disagree on the statement that if for economic reasons only one child in a family can go to the university, it must be a boy. Only 10% of the students did strongly agree on the statement, 8% of the girls and 2% of the boys.
- 78% of the girls but only 49% of the boys did rather or strongly disagree on the statement that teachers treat students differently – they prefer girls, given them higher grades than to boys. 20% of the students did strongly agree on the statement, 8% of the girls and 12% of the boys.
- 67% of the girls and 78% of the boys did rather or strongly disagree on the statement that teachers treat students differently – boys get more attention than girls. 14% of the students did strongly believe in the statement, 10% of the boys and 4% of the girls.
- 65% of the girls and 46% of the boys did strongly or somewhat agree on that girls have more difficulties than boys to study technical subjects. Only 10% of the students did strongly agree on the statement, 2% of the girls and 8% of the boys.
- 80% of the girls and 72% of the boys did rather or strongly disagree on the statement that girls study more than boys because they need more time to learn. Only 12% did strongly agree on the statement, 6% of the boys and 6% of the girls.

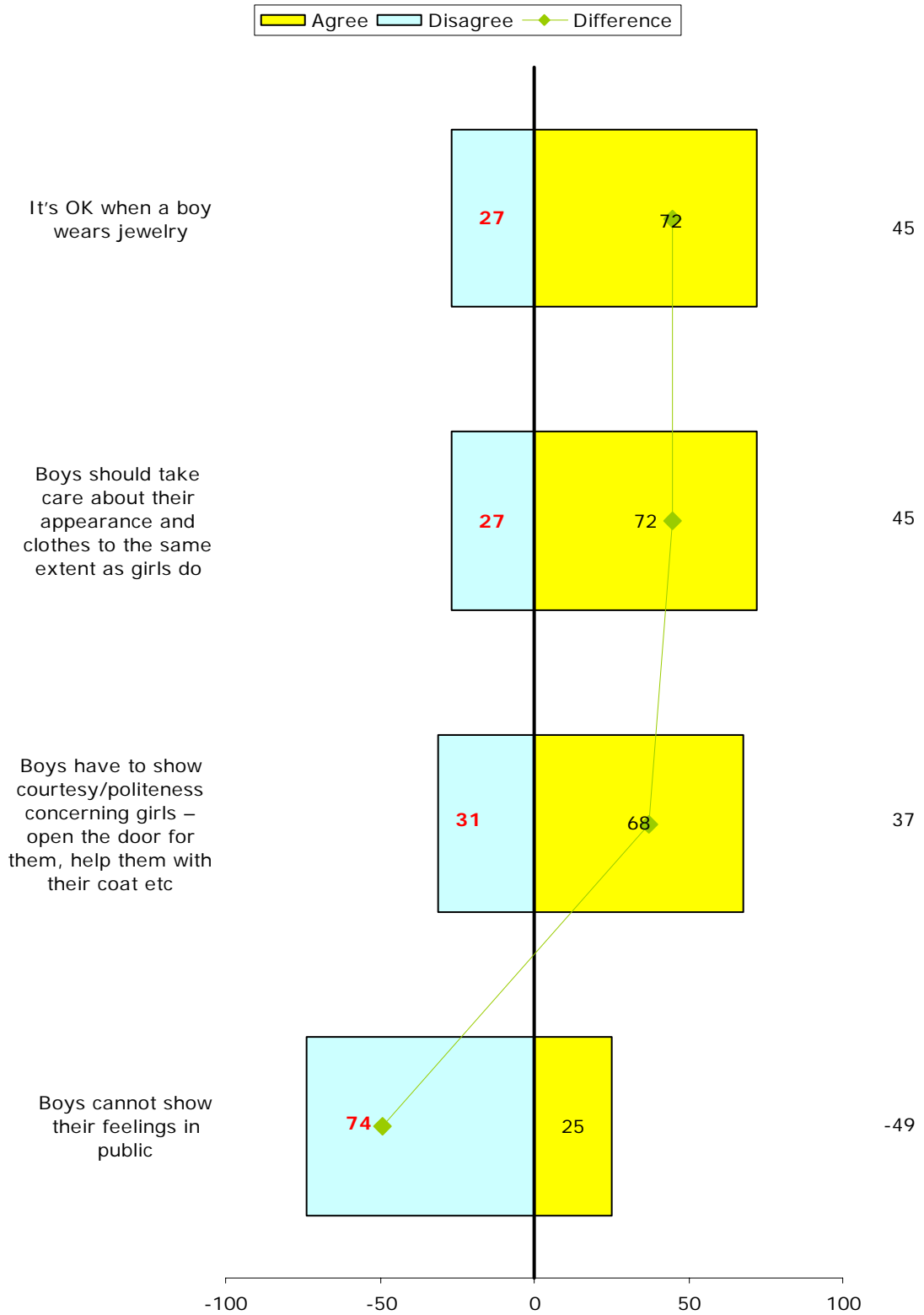

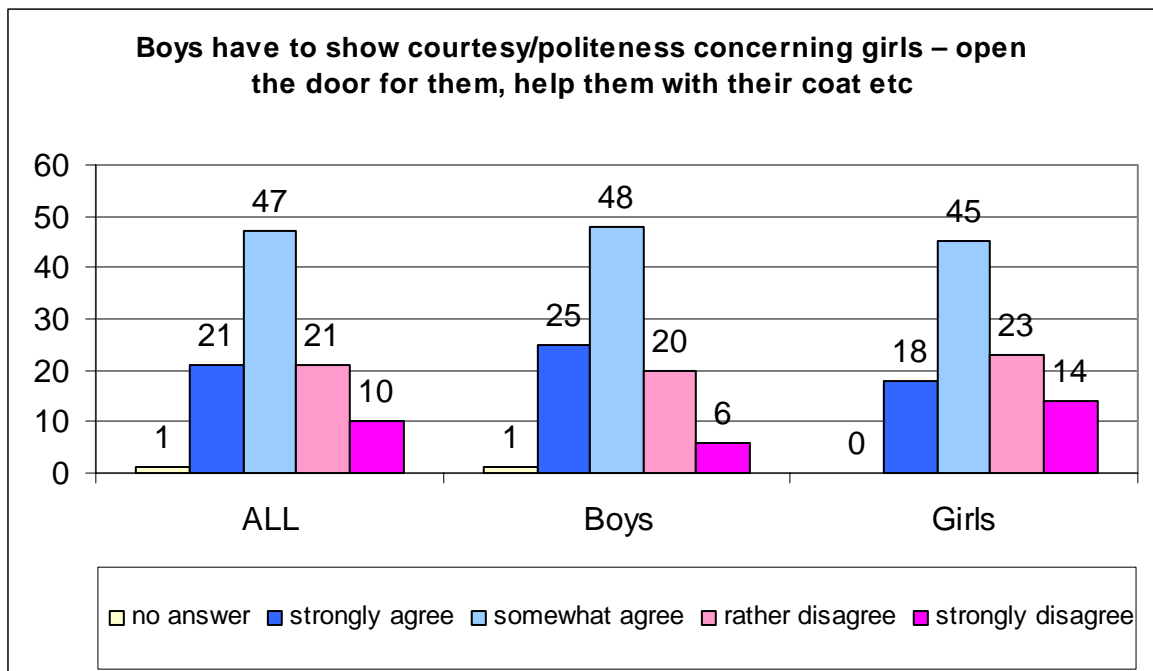
- 98% of the Spanish girls and 82% of the boys did strongly disagree on the statement that if for economic reasons only one child in a family can go to the university, it must be a boy. None (0%) of the Spanish students did strongly believe in the statement.
- 83% of the girls but only 24% of the boys did strongly disagree on the statement that teachers treat students differently – they prefer girls, given them higher grades than to boys. 16% of the boys did strongly agree with the statement but none of the girls (0%).
- 78% of the girls and 72% of the boys did strongly disagree with the statement that teachers treat students differently – boys get more attention than girls. None (0%) of the students did strongly agree on the statement.
- 89% of the girls and 70% of the boys did rather or strongly disagree on the statement girls have more difficulties than boys to study technical subjects. Only 12% of the students did strongly agree on the statement, 10% of the boys and 2% of the girls.
- 96% of the girls and 88% of the boys did rather or strongly disagree on the statement that girls study more than boys because they need more time to learn. Only 6% did strongly agree on the statement, 6% of the boys and none (0%) of the girls.

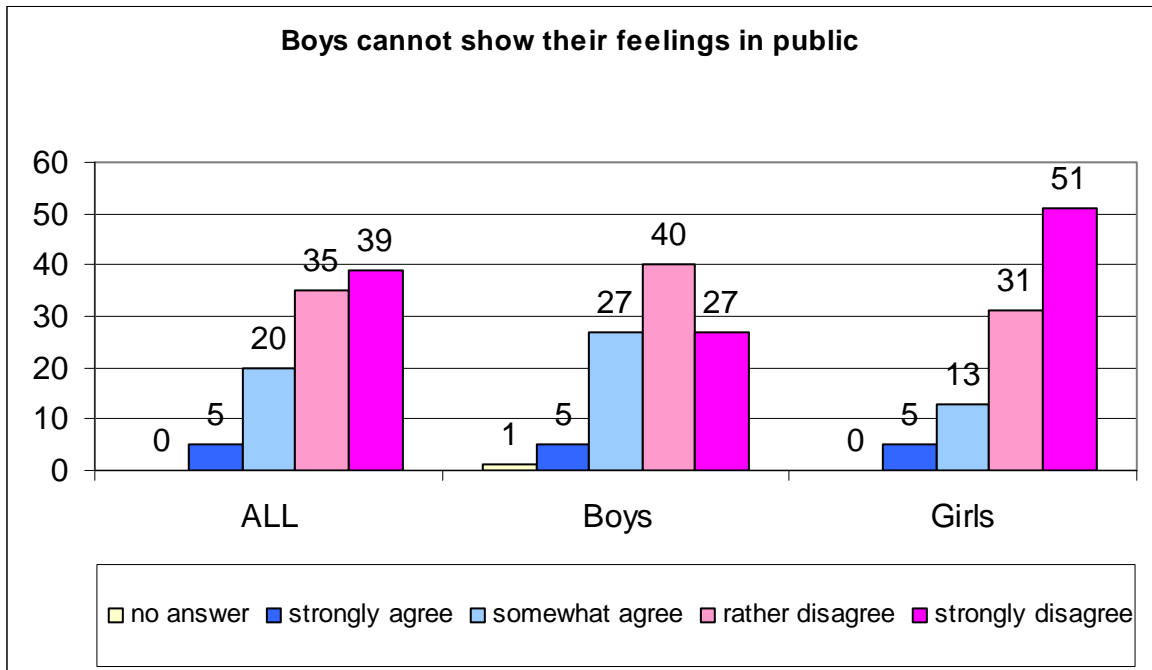

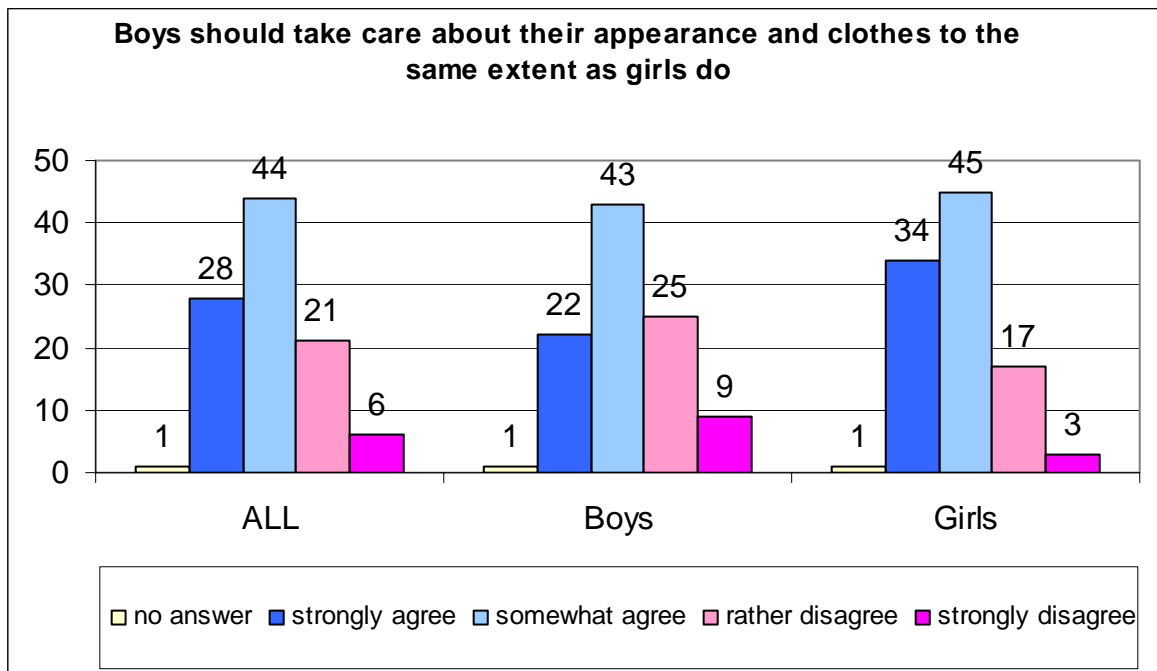

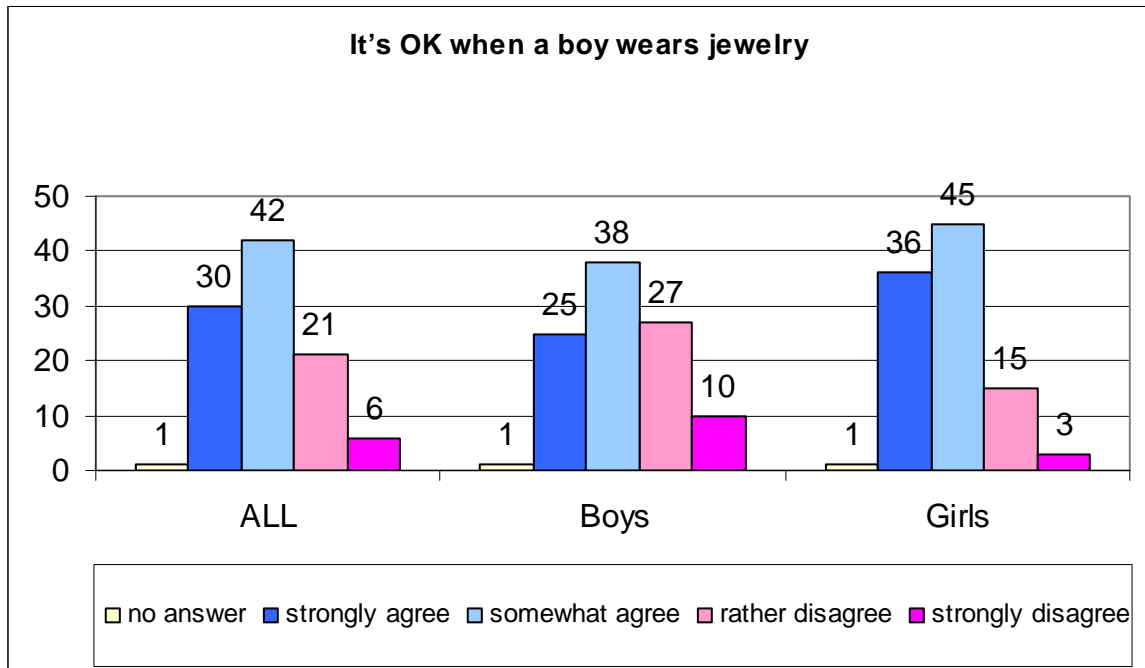
COMMENTS: More boys than girls think that they have to show courtesy/politeness concerning girls – opening door for them, help them with their coat etc. 73% of the boys did strongly or somewhat agree on the statement but only 63% of the girls.



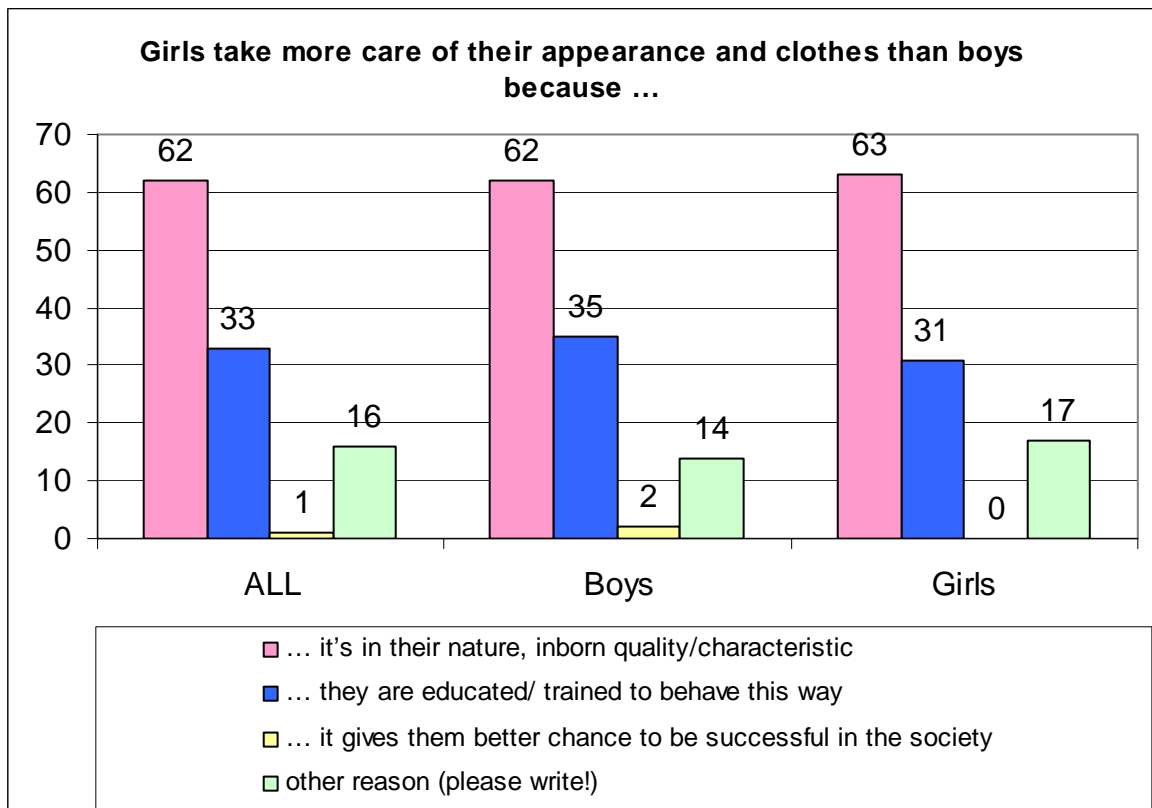
COMMENTS: More girls or 82% than boys or 67% do rather or strongly disagree on the statement that boys cannot show their feelings in public.



COMMENTS: Much higher number of girls (79%) than boys 65% did strongly or somewhat agree on that boys should take care about their appearance and clothes to the same extent as girl do.



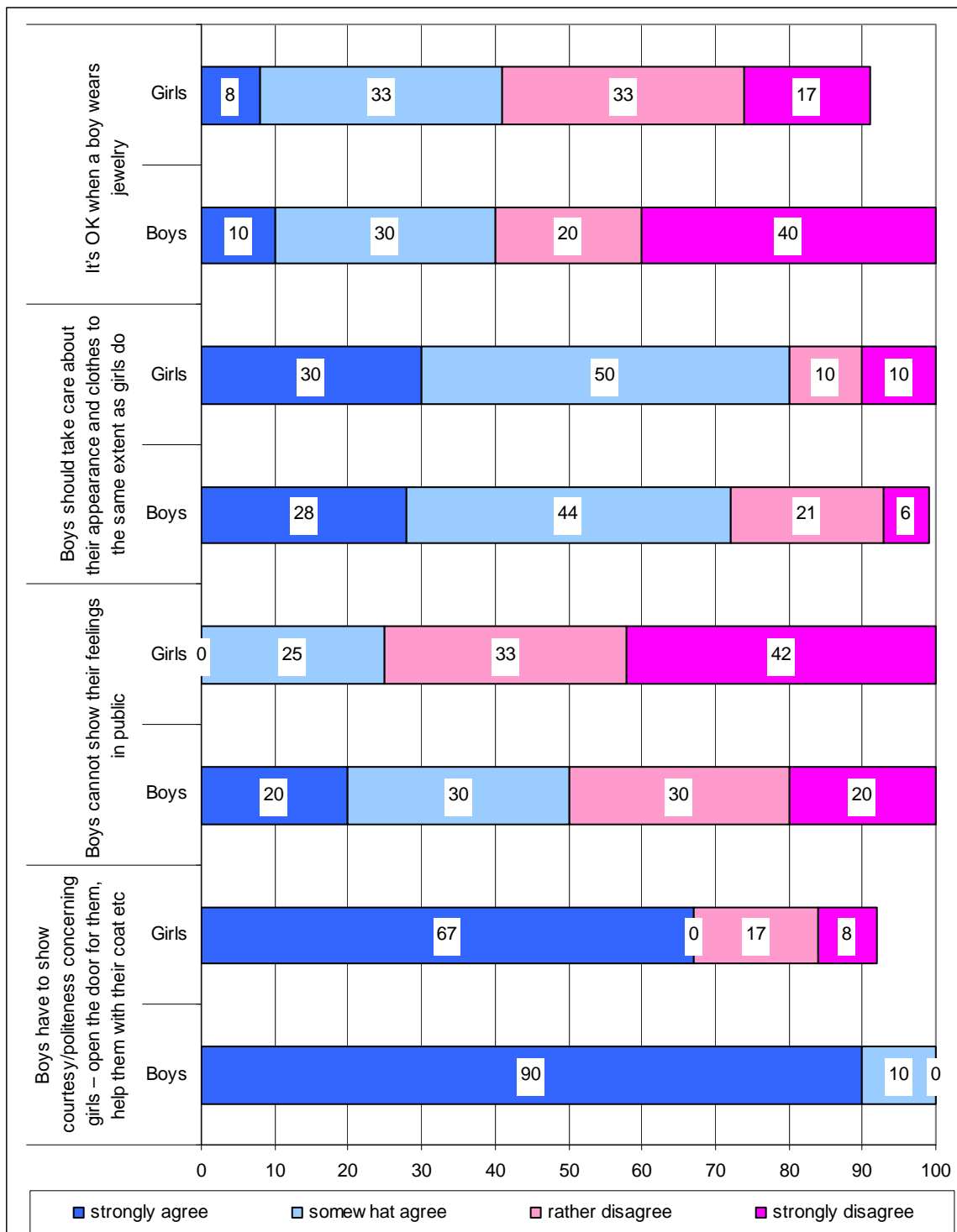
COMMENTS: Both sexes are positive to that it's ok when a boy wears jewellery, but the girls do more strongly or somewhat agree (81%) on the statement than boys (63%).



It's no relative difference in the answers between the sexes on the statement that girls take more care of their appearance and clothes than boys. The majority (62%) did agree on that its in their (the girls) nature, inborn quality/characteristic.

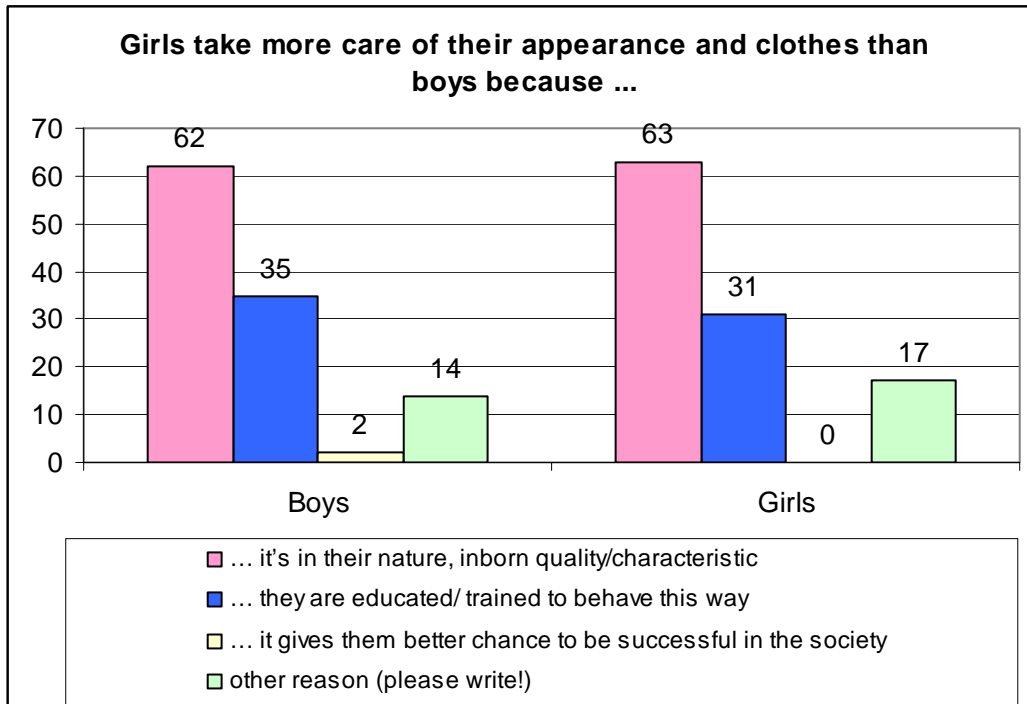

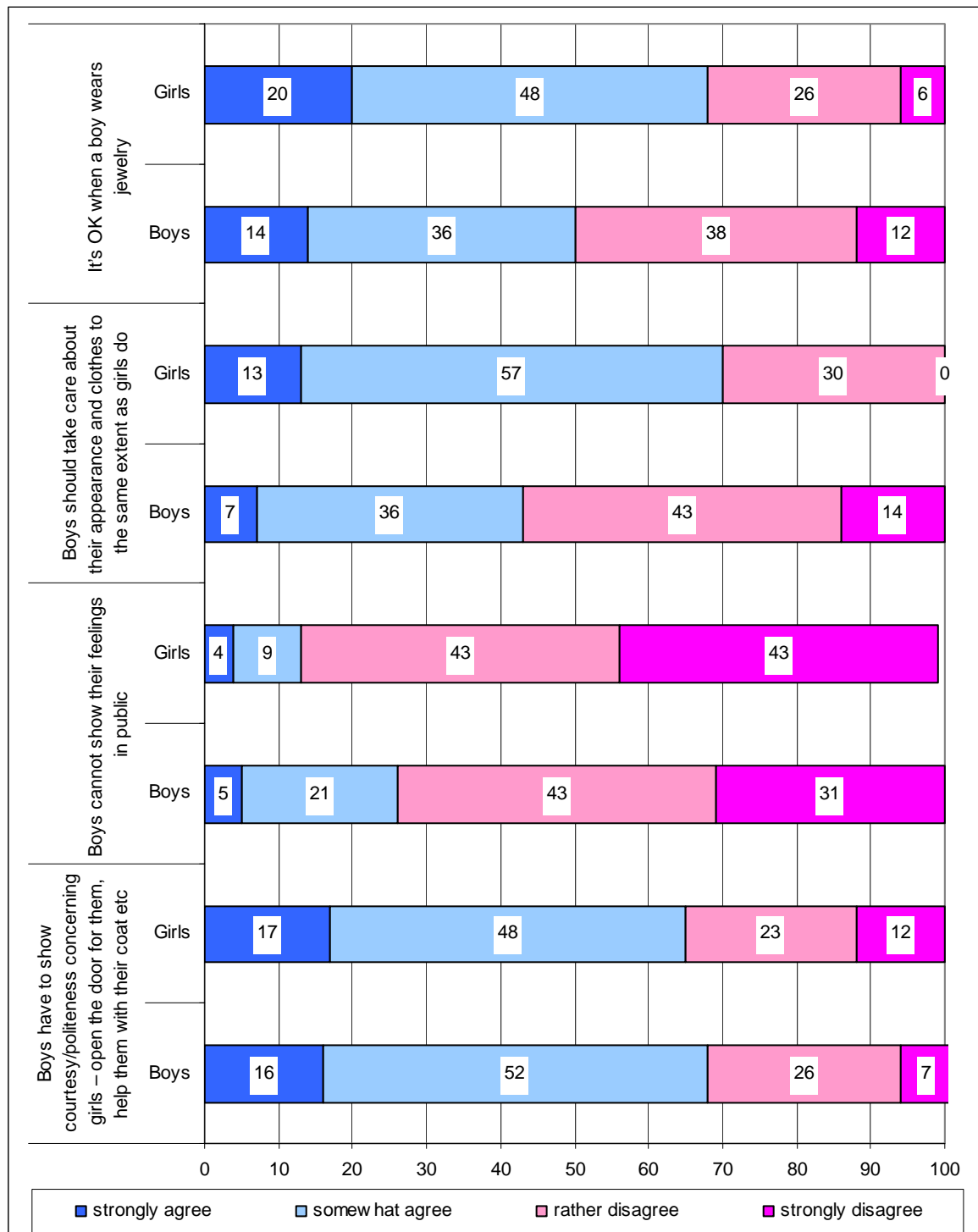
Armenia

- More Armenian boys (60%) than girls (50%) do rather or strongly disagree on the statement that it's ok when a boy wears jewellery. The number of students who strongly agree on the statement is similar, or 8% of the girls and 10% of the boys. Answers from 9% of the girls are missing in this question.
- The majority of the students or 80% of the girls and 72% of the boys did agree strongly or somewhat on the statement that boys should take care about their appearance and clothes to the same extent as girls do.
- Much greater number of girls (75%) than boys (50%) did rather or strongly disagree on the statement that boys cannot show their feelings in public. None of the girls did strongly agree on the statement but 20% of the boys did so.
- Huge majority of the students did strongly agree on that boys have to show courtesy/politeness concerning girls – open the doors for them, help them with their coat etc. 90% of the boys did strongly agree on the statement and 67% of the girls. None (0%) of the boys did rather or strongly disagree but 25% of the girls did so.



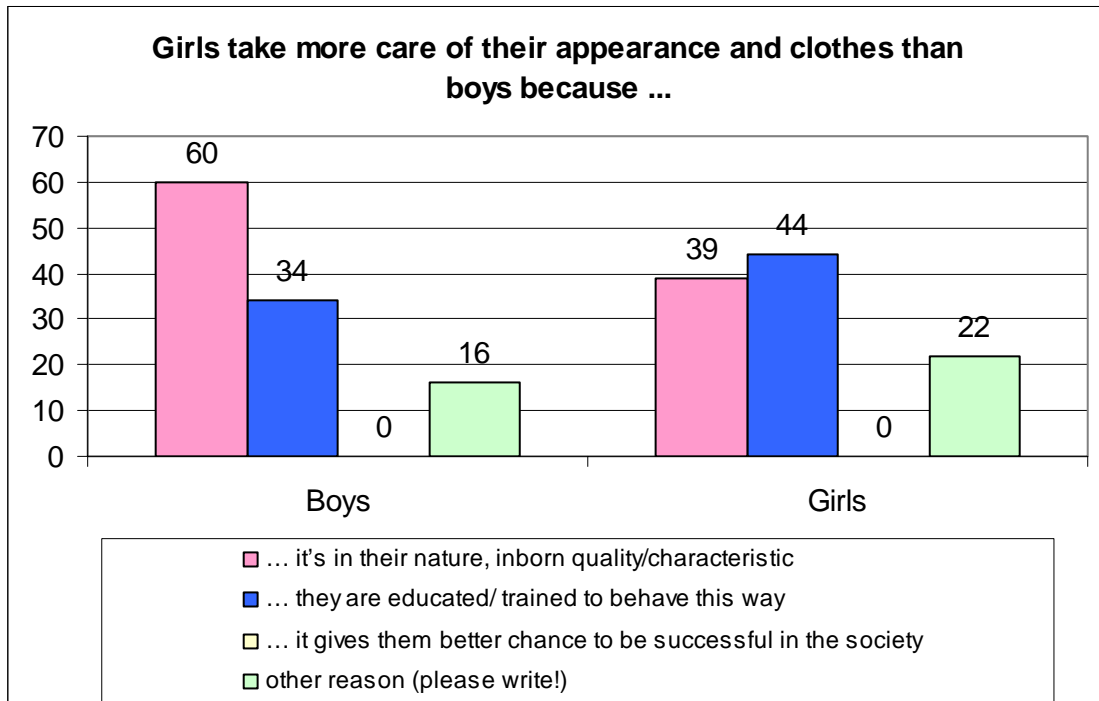
There are very little differences between the sexes on the statement that girls take more care of their appearance and clothes than boys – the majority or 62% of the boys and 63% of the girls believe that it is in their (girls) nature, inborn quality/characteristic.

BELGIUM



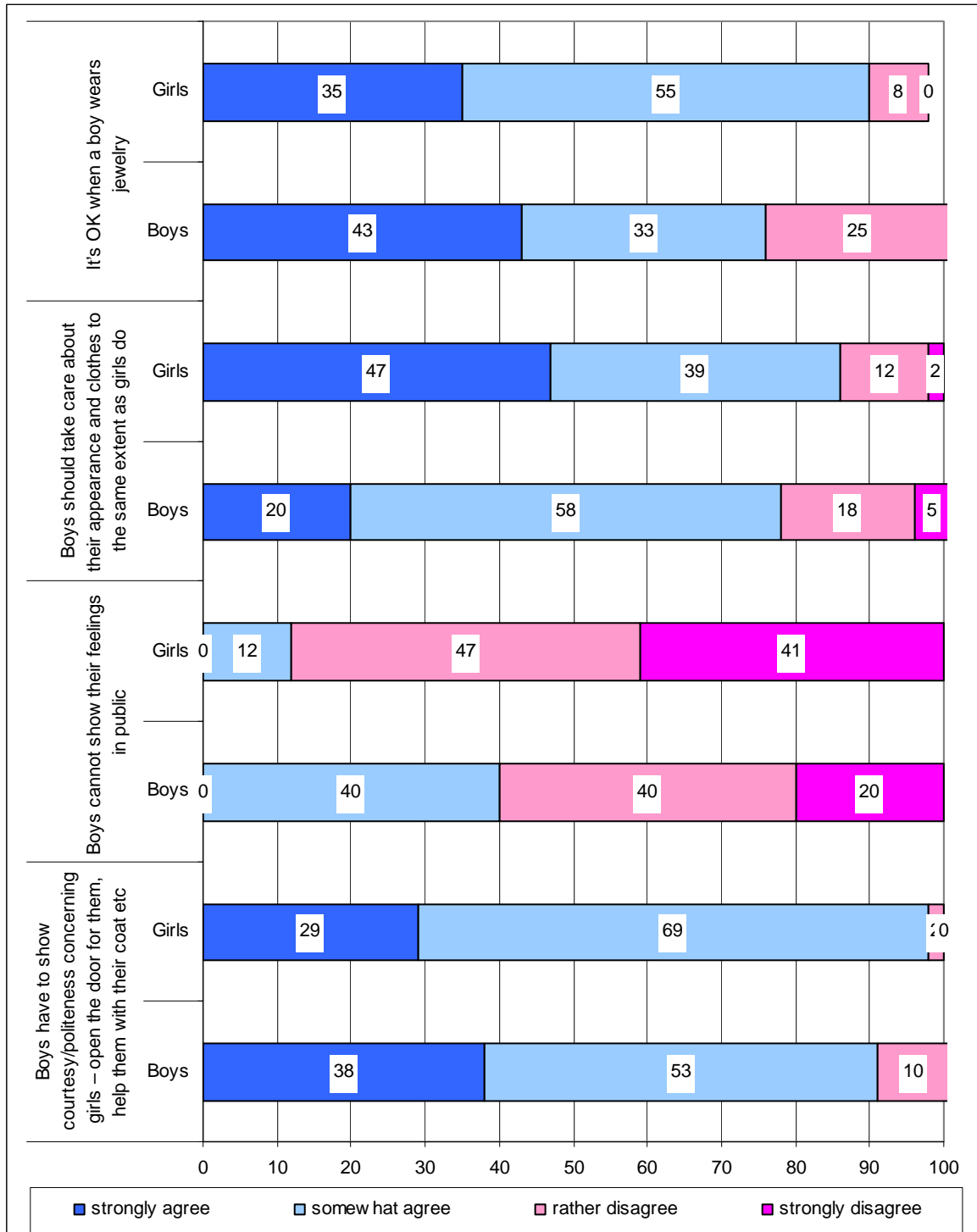
Belgium

- The majority of the Belgian girls (68%) and the half of the boys (50%) think that it's ok when a boy wears a jewellery. Half of the boys do rather or strongly disagree on this statement but only 32% of the girls.
- The majority of the girls or 70% but only 43% of the boys, do strongly or somewhat agree on the statement that boys should take care about their appearance and clothes to the same extent as girls do. None of the girls (0%) but 14% of the boys did strongly disagree on this statement.
- Huge majority of the students rejected the statement that that boys cannot show their feelings in public. 86% of the girls and 74% of the boys did rather or strongly disagree on the statement. Only 4% of the girls and 5% of the boys did strongly agree on the statement.
- The majority of the students, or 65% of the girls and 68% of the boys believe that boys have to show courtesy/politeness concerning girls – open the doors for them, help them with their coat etc. 12% of the girls and 7% of the boys did though strongly disagree on the statement.



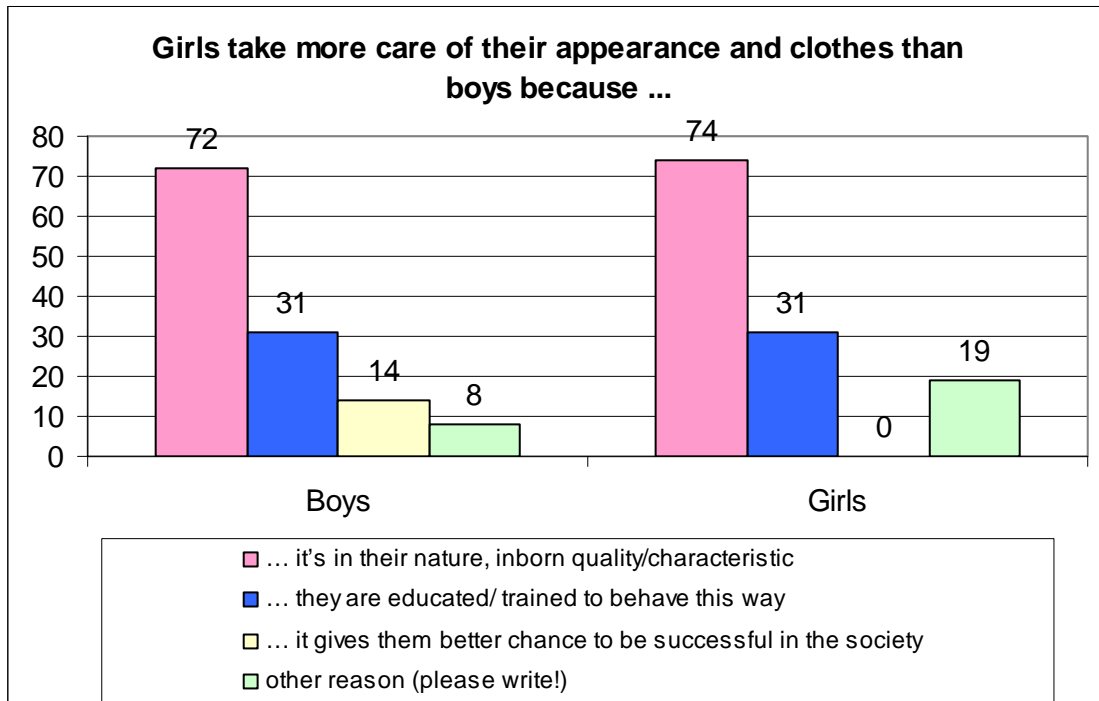
Here we see differences in answers between the gender, 60% of the boys think that girls take more care of their appearance and clothes than boys because it's in their nature, inborn quality/characteristic but only 39% of the girls share that believe, they rather think that they are educated/trained do behave this way.

ESTONIA



Estonia

- Huge majority of the Estonian students think that it is ok when a boy wears jewellery. More girls or 90% than girls (76%) do strongly or somewhat agree on the statement. None of the students did strongly disagree but ¼ of the boys and 8% of the girls did rather disagree.
- The majority of the girls or 86 % and 78% of the boys do strongly or somewhat agree on the statement that boys should take care about their appearance and clothes to the same extent as girls do. Only 2% of the girls (0%) and 5% of the boys did strongly disagree on this statement.
- The majority of the students rejected the statement that that boys cannot show their feelings in public, but the boys where more unsecured than the girls on this statement. 88% of the girls and 60% of the boys did rather or strongly disagree on the statement. None of the students did strongly agree but 12% of the girls and 40% of the boys did somewhat agree on the statement.
- Huge majority of the students or 98% of the girls and 91% of the boys believe that boys have to show courtesy//politeness concerning girls – open the doors for them, help them with their coat etc. None of the students do strongly disagree on this statement.



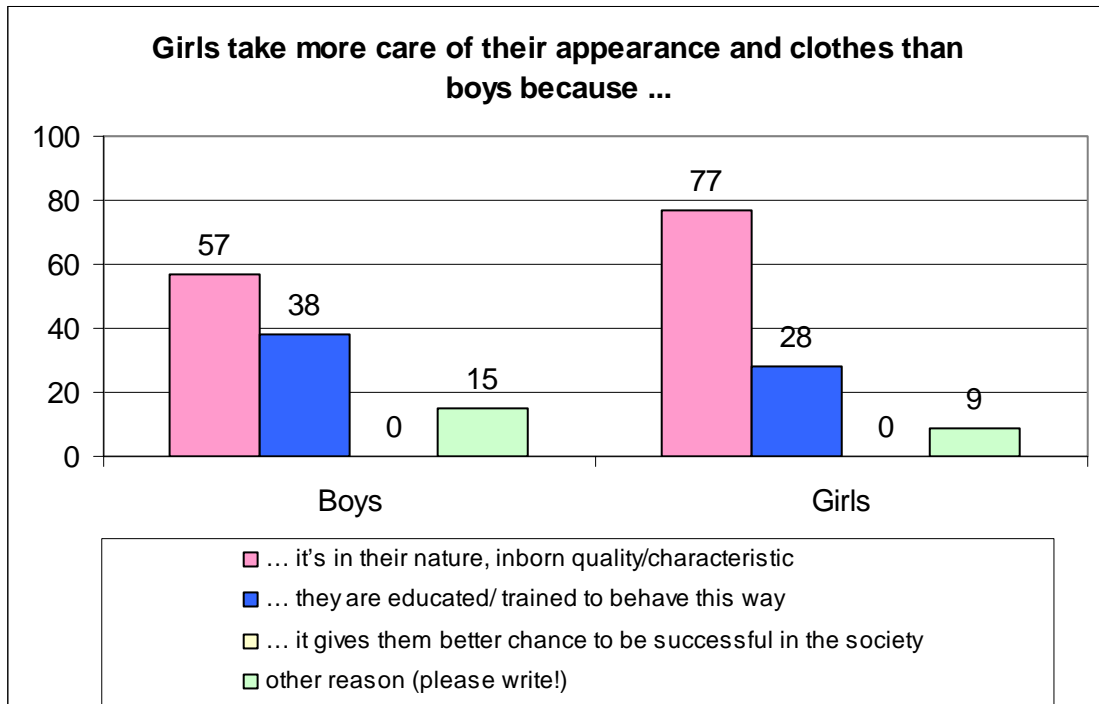
There are little differences in the answers according to this question between gender. The majority of both sexes, or 72% of the boys and 74% of the girls believes that girls take more care of their appearance and clothes than boys because it's in their nature, inborn quality/characteristic.

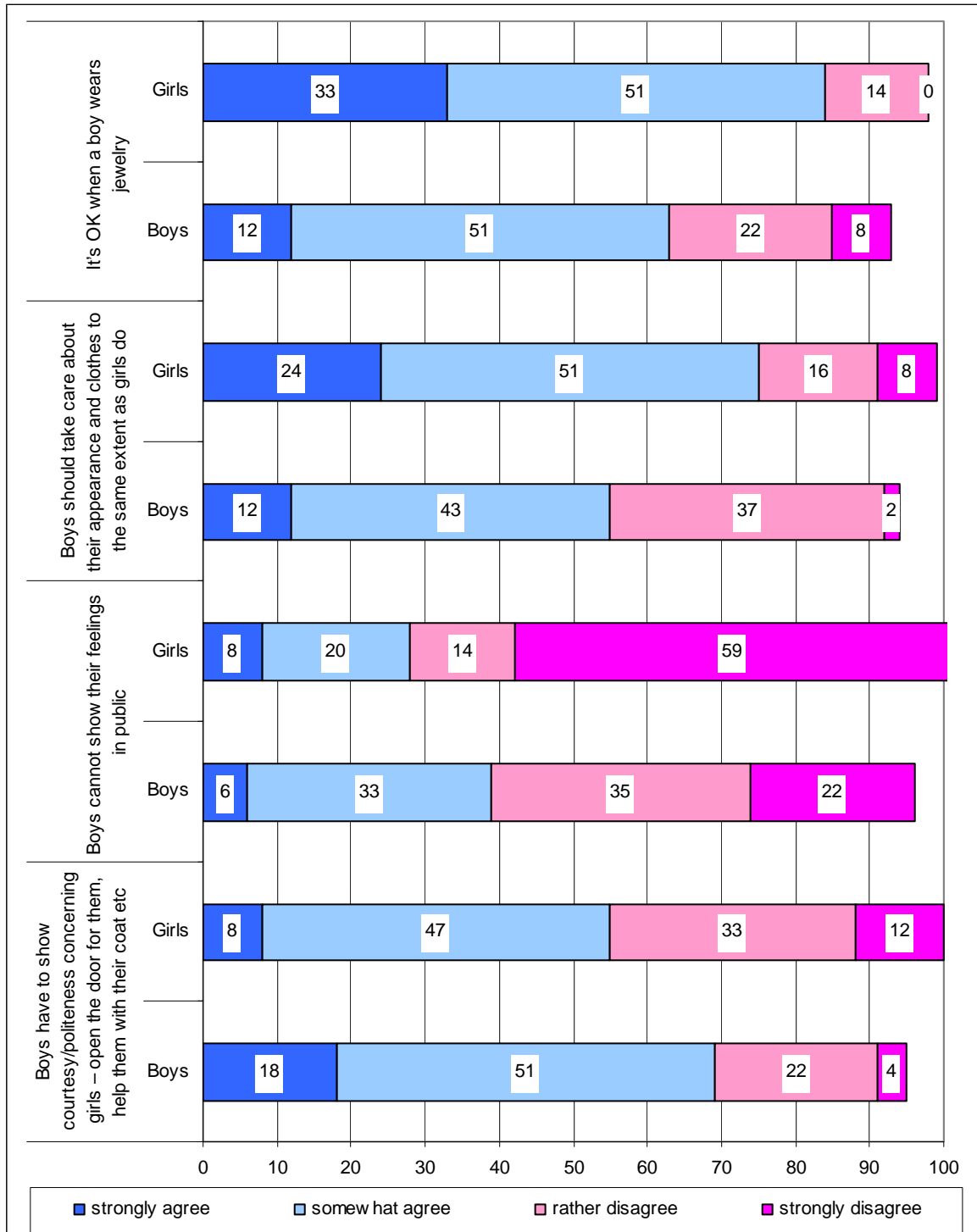
Iceland

- Huge majority of the Icelandic girls or 81% but only 55% of the boys think that it is ok when a boy wears jewellery. 32% of the girls and 14% of the boys do strongly agree on the statement. 3% of the girls and 14% of the boys did strongly disagree the statement.
- The majority of the girls or 79 % and 65% of the boys do strongly or somewhat agree on the statement that boys should take care about their appearance and clothes to the same extent as girls do. Only 3% of the girls but 14% of the boys did strongly disagree on this statement.
- The majority of the students rejected the statement that that boys cannot show their feelings in public, but the boys where more unsecured than the girls. 69% of the girls and 57% of the boys did rather or strongly disagree on the statement. 11% of the girls and 8% of the boys did strongly agree on the statement.
- More boys (67%) than girls (60%) believe that boys have to show courtesy//politeness concerning girls – open the doors for them, help them with their coat etc. 15% of the girls and only 5% of the boys do strongly disagree on this statement.



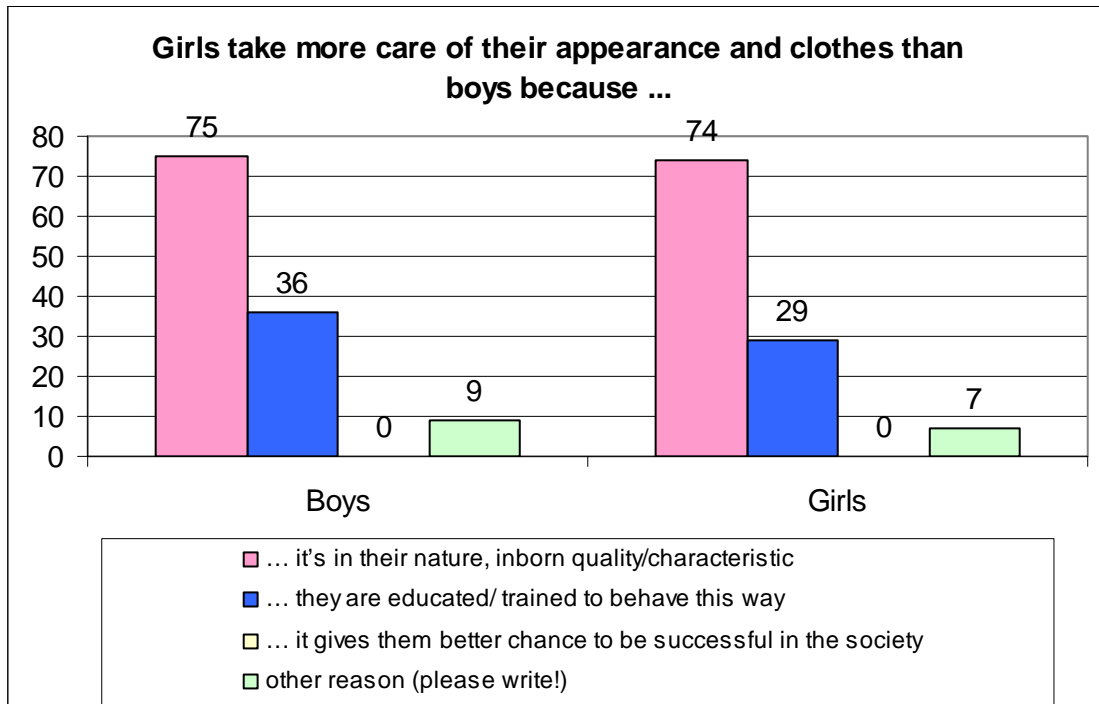
Both sexes believe that girls take more care of their appearance and clothes than boys because it's in their nature, inborn quality/characteristic, but there are huge gender differences in the answers, since 77% of the girls and only 57% of the boys believe that the difference lies in the girls it's in their nature, inborn quality/characteristic.

NORWAY



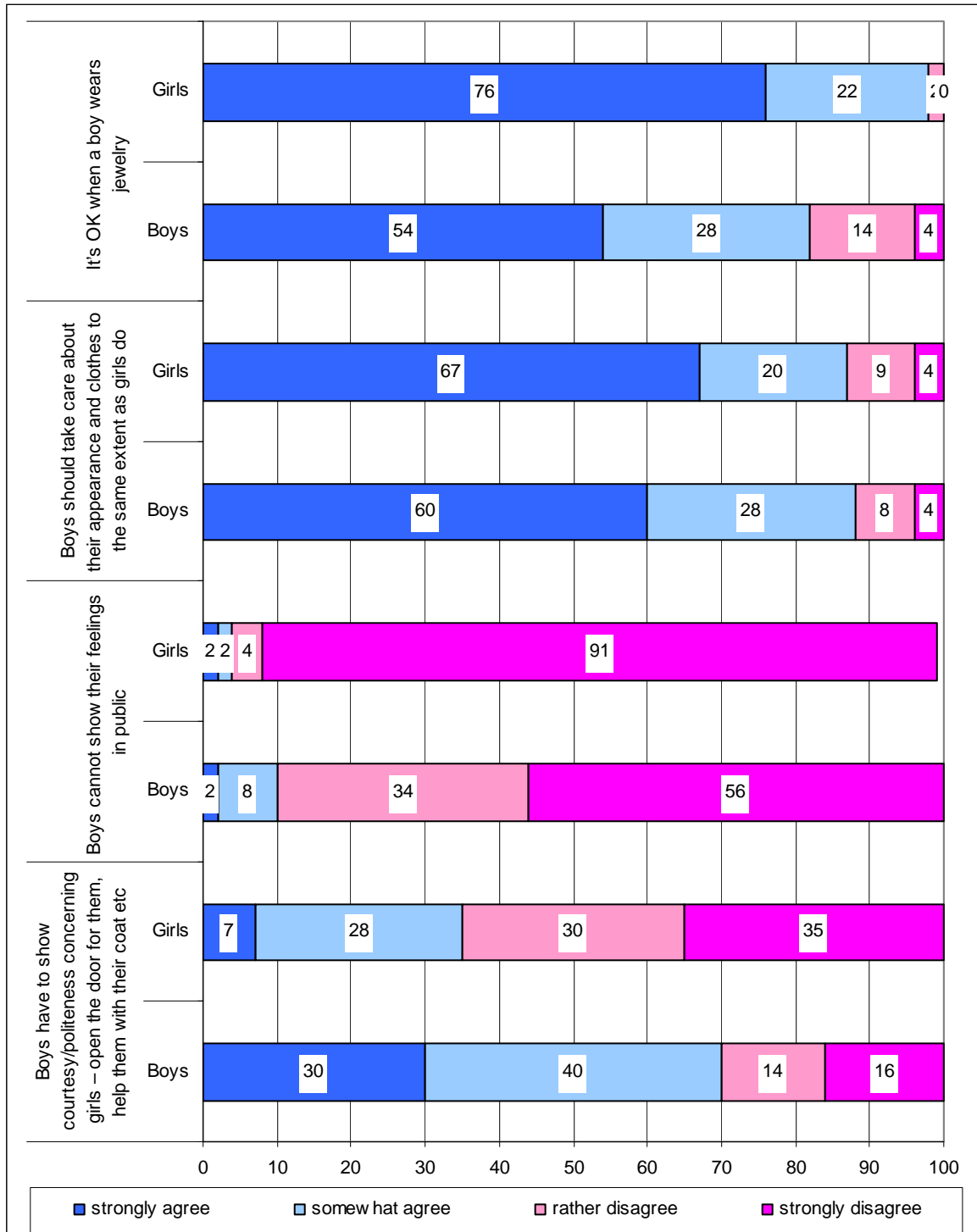
Norway

- Huge majority of the Norwegian girls or 84% but only 63% of the boys think that it is ok when a boy wears jewellery. 33% of the girls and 12% of the boys do strongly agree on the statement. None of the girls but 8% of the boys did strongly disagree the statement.
- The majority of the girls or 75 % but only 55% of the boys do strongly or somewhat agree on the statement that boys should take care about their appearance and clothes to the same extent as girls do. Only 2% of the boys and 8% of the girls did strongly disagree on this statement.
- The majority of the students rejected the statement that that boys cannot show their feelings in public, but the boys where more unsecured than the girls. 73% of the girls and 57% of the boys did rather or strongly disagree on the statement. 8% of the girls and 6% of the boys did strongly agree on the statement.
- More boys (69%) than girls (55%) believe that boys have to show courtesy/politeness concerning girls – open the doors for them, help them with their coat etc. 12% of the girls but only 4% of the boys do strongly disagree on this statement.



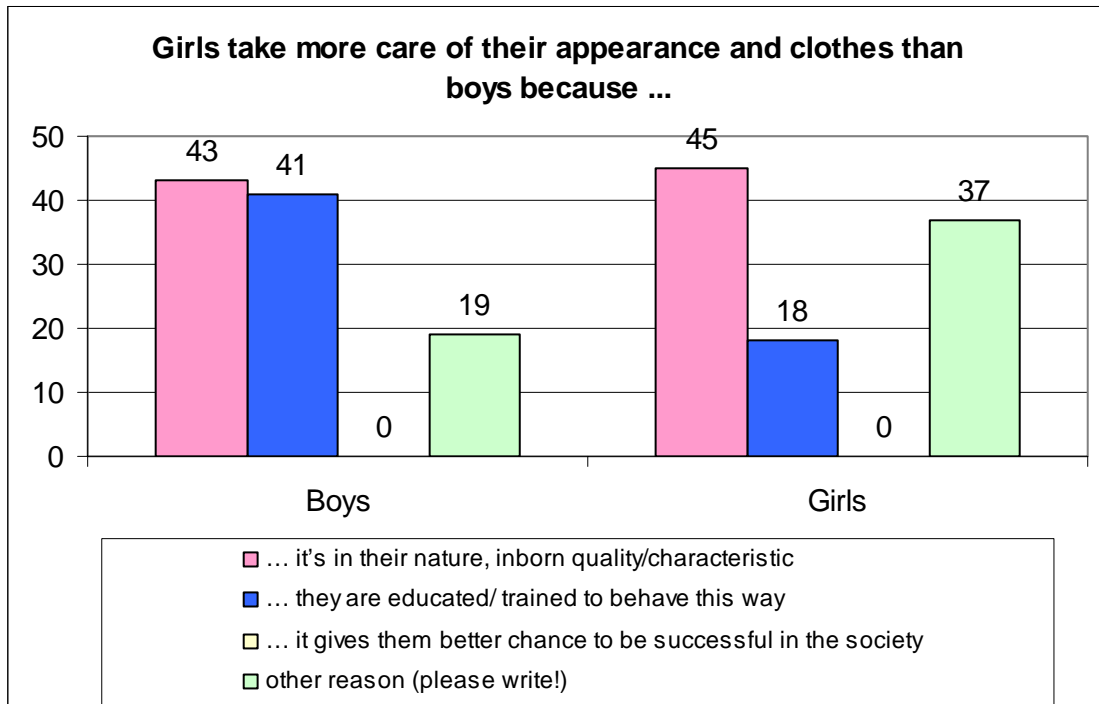
There are little differences in the answers according too this question between gender. The majority of both sexes, or 75% of the boys and 74% of the girls believes that girls take more care of their appearance and clothes than boys because it's in their nature, inborn quality/characteristic.

SPAIN



Spain

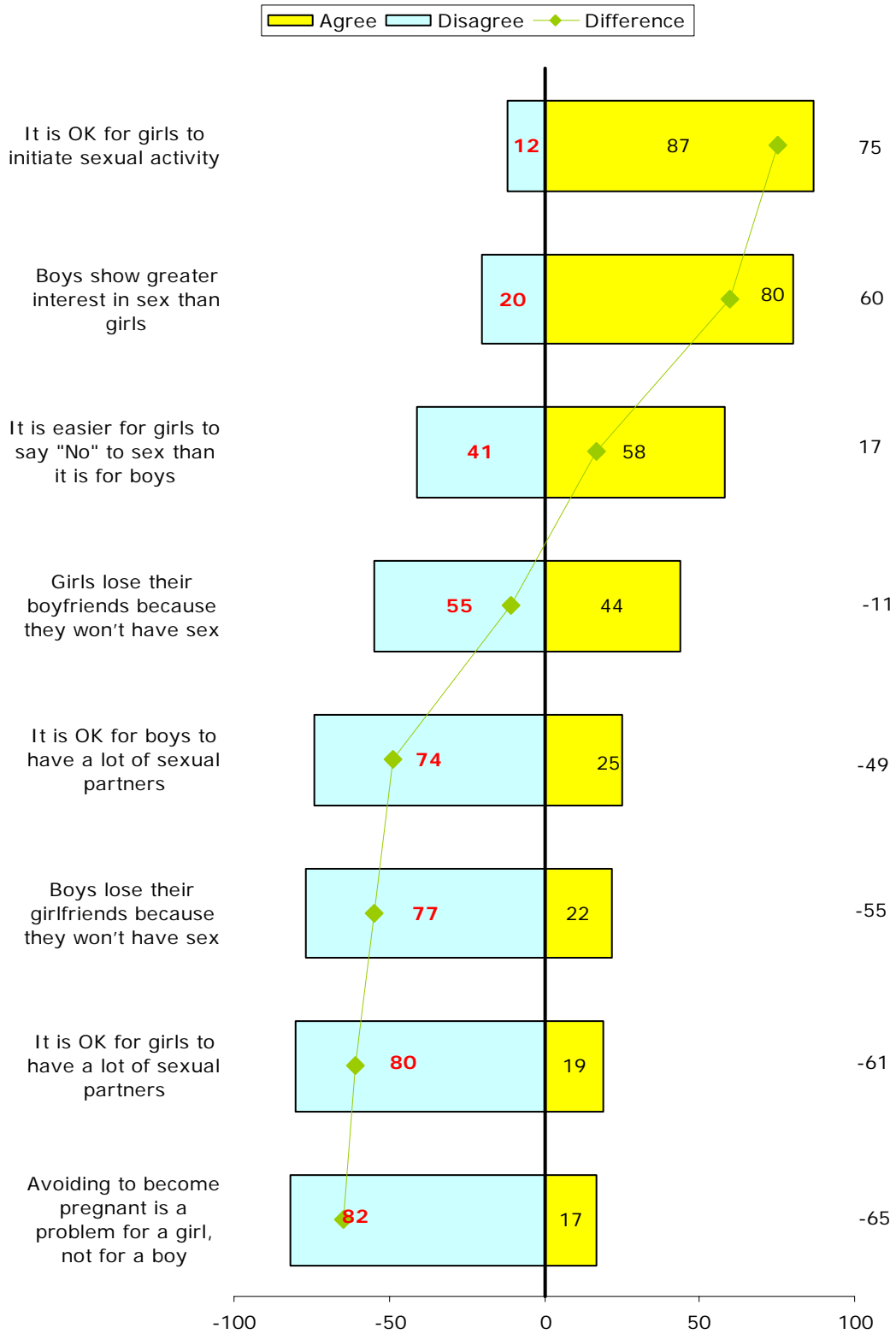
- Huge majority of the Spanish girls or 98% and 82% of the boys think that it is ok when a boy wears jewellery. 76% of the girls and 54% of the boys do strongly agree on the statement. None of the girls and 4% of the boys did strongly disagree the statement.
- There is not much differences between the sexes in the answers of this question. 87 % of the girls and 88% of the boys do strongly or somewhat agree on the statement that boys should take care about their appearance and clothes to the same extent as girls do. Only 4% of the boys and the girls did strongly disagree on this statement.
- Almost all of the students rejected the statement that that boys cannot show their feelings in public, but the boys where not as strong in their opinion as the girls. 95% of the girls did rather or strongly disagree on the statement (91% of them strongly). 90% of the boys did rather or strongly disagree on the statement (56% of them strongly). Only 2% of the girls and 2% of the boys did strongly agree on the statement.
- The majority of the boys or 70% believe that boys have to show courtesy/politeness concerning girls – open the doors for them, help them with their coat etc. Only 35% of the girls share their opinion on that statement. 35% of the girls and 16% of the boys do strongly disagree on this statement.



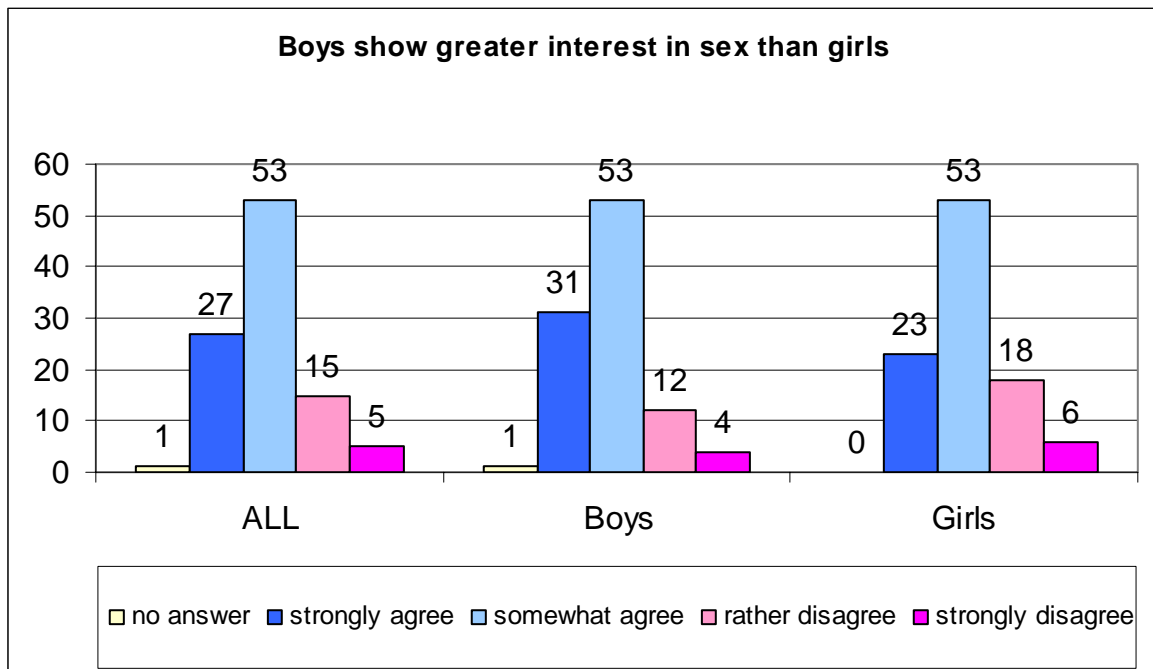
Most of the students believe that that girls take more care of their appearance and clothes than boys because it's in their nature, inborn quality/characteristic, or 43% of the boys and 45% of the girls. Notice that 41% of the boys but only 18% of the girls believe that the statement is because they (girls) are educated/trained to behave this way.

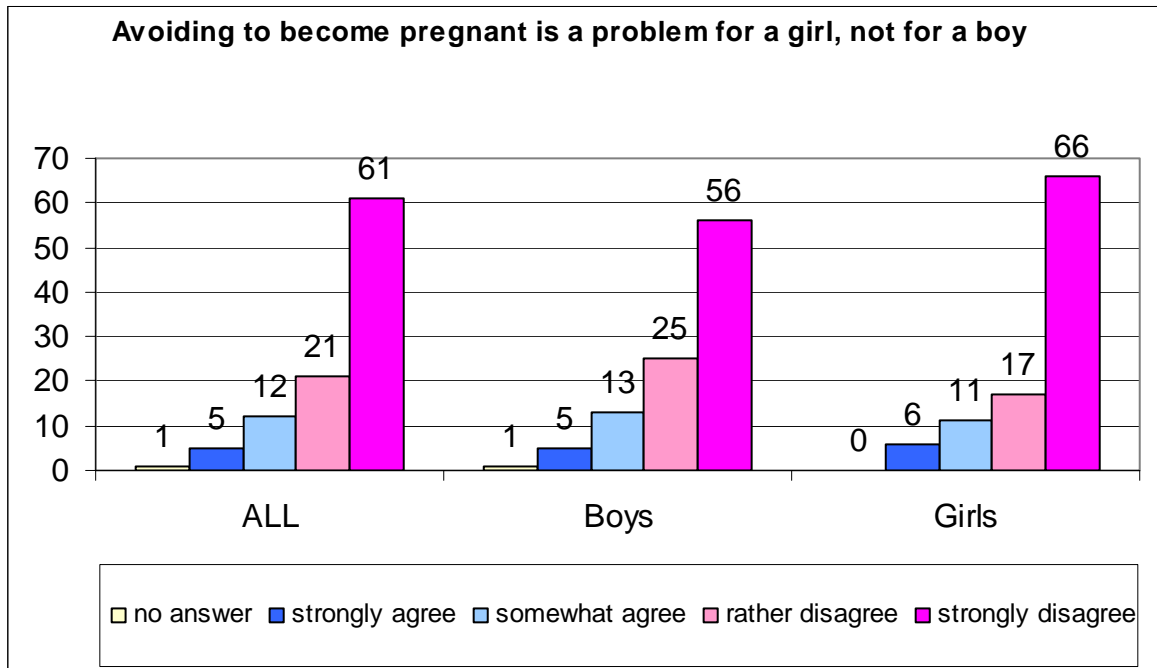

- Almost all of the Icelandic students do agree on that it is all right for couple to live together without intention to get married. 98% of the girls do agree, thereof do 83% strongly agree. A little less or 96% of the boys do agree on the statement, thereof do 69% strongly agree. None of the girls and 1% of the boys do strongly disagree.
- Most of the girls or 80% compared with 56% of the boys agree on that that divorce is usually the best solution when a couple does not seem to work out their marriage problems. 34% of the girls and 18% of the boys do strongly agree. Fewer girls or 8% than boys or 11% of the boys do strongly disagree.
- Most of the girls or 80% do disagree on the statement that men are better leaders than women, thereof do 37% strongly disagree. The majority of boys or 61% do think that men are better leaders than women, thereof do 23% strongly agree..
- Majority of the girls or 69% do agree on that women are usually underpaid at workplaces, thereof do 23% strongly agree. Also the majority of the boys or 62% do agree, thereof do 15% strongly agree.
- Much higher number of girls (83%) than boys (64%) do agree on that women themselves should decide if they want abortion or not. 49% of the girls and 28% of the boys do strongly agree on the statement. Only 3% of the girls and 8% of the boys do strongly disagree.
- More girls (88%) than boys (72%) do agree on that in modern societies, more possibilities should be created for woman to participate in economical and political life. 42% of the girls but only 23% of the boys do strongly agree on the statement. Only 2% of the girls and 4% of the boys do strongly disagree.
- Slightly majority of the students do disagree on the statement that the society should not tolerate homosexuality. 59% of the girls did disagree, thereof do 45% strongly disagree. 54% of the boys do disagree, thereof do 35% of them strongly disagree. 26% of the girls and 23% of the boys do strongly agree on the statement.
- Only 43% of the girls but 55% of the boys do agree on that to be a prostitute is a free choice of a women to sell her body. 18% of the girls and 28% of the boys do strongly agree on the statement. About ¼ of both sexes (26% of the girls and 22% of the boys) do strongly disagree on the statement.
- The sexes have different opinions according to that the distribution of pornography in media should be restricted. The majority of girls do agree, thereof do 25% of them strongly agree. Only 46% of the boys do agree, thereof do 18% strongly agree. 6% of the girls and 26% of the boys do strongly disagree on the statement.

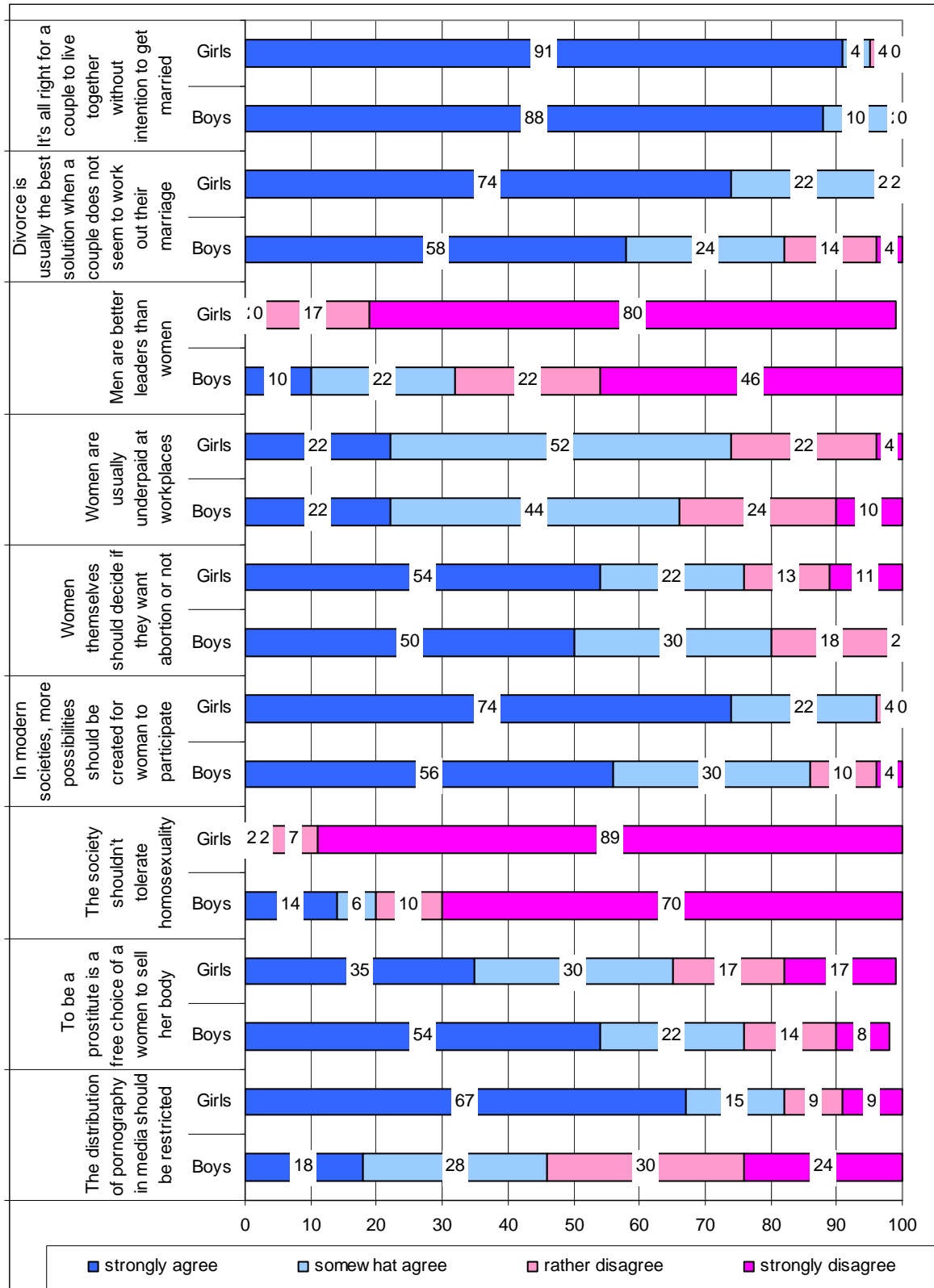
NORWAY



Norway

- Almost all of the Norwegian students do agree on that it is all right for couple to live together without intention to get married. 86% of the girls do agree, thereof do 76% strongly agree. A little more or 94% of the boys do agree on the statement, thereof do 76% strongly agree. None of the boys but 8% of the girls do strongly disagree.
- Almost the same number of students or 69% of the girls and 73% of the boys do agree on that that divorce is usually the best solution when a couple does not seem to work out their marriage problems. Same number of girls and boys or 24% do strongly agree, but none of the boys but 8% of the girls do strongly disagree on the statement.
- Most of the girls or 86% do disagree on the statement that men are better leaders than women, thereof do 49% strongly disagree. The majority of boys or 51% do think that men are better leaders than women, thereof do only 4% strongly agree. 5% of the girls do strongly agree but 16% of the boys do strongly disagree.
- Majority of the girls or 55% do agree on that women are usually underpaid at workplaces, thereof do 14% strongly agree. Minority of the boys or 45% do agree, thereof do 12% strongly agree.
- More girls (88%) than boys (74%) do agree on that women themselves should decide if they want abortion or not. 59% of the girls and 45% of the boys do strongly agree on the statement. Only 2% of the girls and 8% of the boys do strongly disagree.
- More girls (86%) than boys (65%) do agree on that in modern societies, more possibilities should be created for woman to participate in economical and political life. 31% of the girls and 24% of the boys do strongly agree on the statement. Only 2% of the girls and 10% of the boys do strongly disagree.
- Much higher number of girls or 83% than boys or 51% do disagree on the statement that the society should not tolerate homosexuality. 61% of the girls but only 33% of the boys do strongly disagree. The same number of girls and boys or 12% do strongly agree on the statement.
- Only 45% of the girls but 51% of the boys do agree on that to be a prostitute is a free choice of a women to sell her body. 14% of the girls and 18% of the boys do strongly agree on the statement. About 1/4 of the girls (25%) and 10% of the boys do strongly disagree on the statement.
- The majority of both sexes do agree on that the distribution of pornography in media should be restricted. More girls or 67% than boys or 51% do agree. 1/5 of the girls or 20% did strongly agree on the statement compared with 14% of the boys.

SPAIN



Spain

- Almost all of the Spanish students do agree on that it is all right for couple to live together without intention to get married. 95% of the girls do agree, thereof do 91% strongly agree. A little more or 98% of the boys do agree on the statement, thereof do 88% strongly agree. None of the students do strongly disagree.
- Most of the girls or 96% and 82% of the boys do agree on that that divorce is usually the best solution when a couple does not seem to work out their marriage problems. 74% of the girls and 82% of the boys do strongly agree on the statement. Only 2% of the girls and 4% of the boys do strongly disagree on the statement.
- Much higher number of girls or 97% do than boys or 68% do disagree on the statement that men are better leaders than women. As many as 80% of the girls and 46% of the boys do strongly disagree but only 1% of the girls and 10% of the boys did agree on the statement.
- $\frac{3}{4}$ of the girls or 74% do agree on that women are usually underpaid at workplaces, thereof do 22% strongly agree. Majority of the boys or 66% think so to, thereof do 22% strongly agree.
- More boys (80%) than girls (76%) do agree on that women themselves should decide if they want abortion or not. 54% of the girls and 50% of the boys do strongly agree on the statement. Only 2% of the boys but 11% of the girls do strongly disagree.
- Nearly all of the girls or 96% and 86% of the boys do agree on that in modern societies, more possibilities should be created for woman to participate in economical and political life. 74% of the girls and 56% of the boys do strongly agree on the statement. None of the girls and 4% of the boys do strongly disagree.
- Huge majority of the Spanish students do disagree on the statement that the society should not tolerate homosexuality. Almost all the girls or 96% do disagree (thereof do 89% strongly disagree) and 80% of the boys do disagree (thereof do 70% strongly disagree). Only 2% of the girls and 14% of the boys do strongly agree on the statement.
- About $\frac{3}{4}$ of the boys (76%) and 65% of the girls do agree on that to be a prostitute is a free choice of a women to sell her body. More than half of the boys (54% and 35% of the girls do strongly believe in the statement. Only 8% of the boys but 17% of the girls do strongly disagree on the statement.
- The majority of girls or 82% do agree, thereof do 67 strongly agree on the statement that the distribution of pornography in media should be restricted. A little less than half of the boys or 46% do agree on the statement, thereof do only 18% strongly agree. Only 9% of the girls but 24% of the boys do strongly disagree on the statement.
